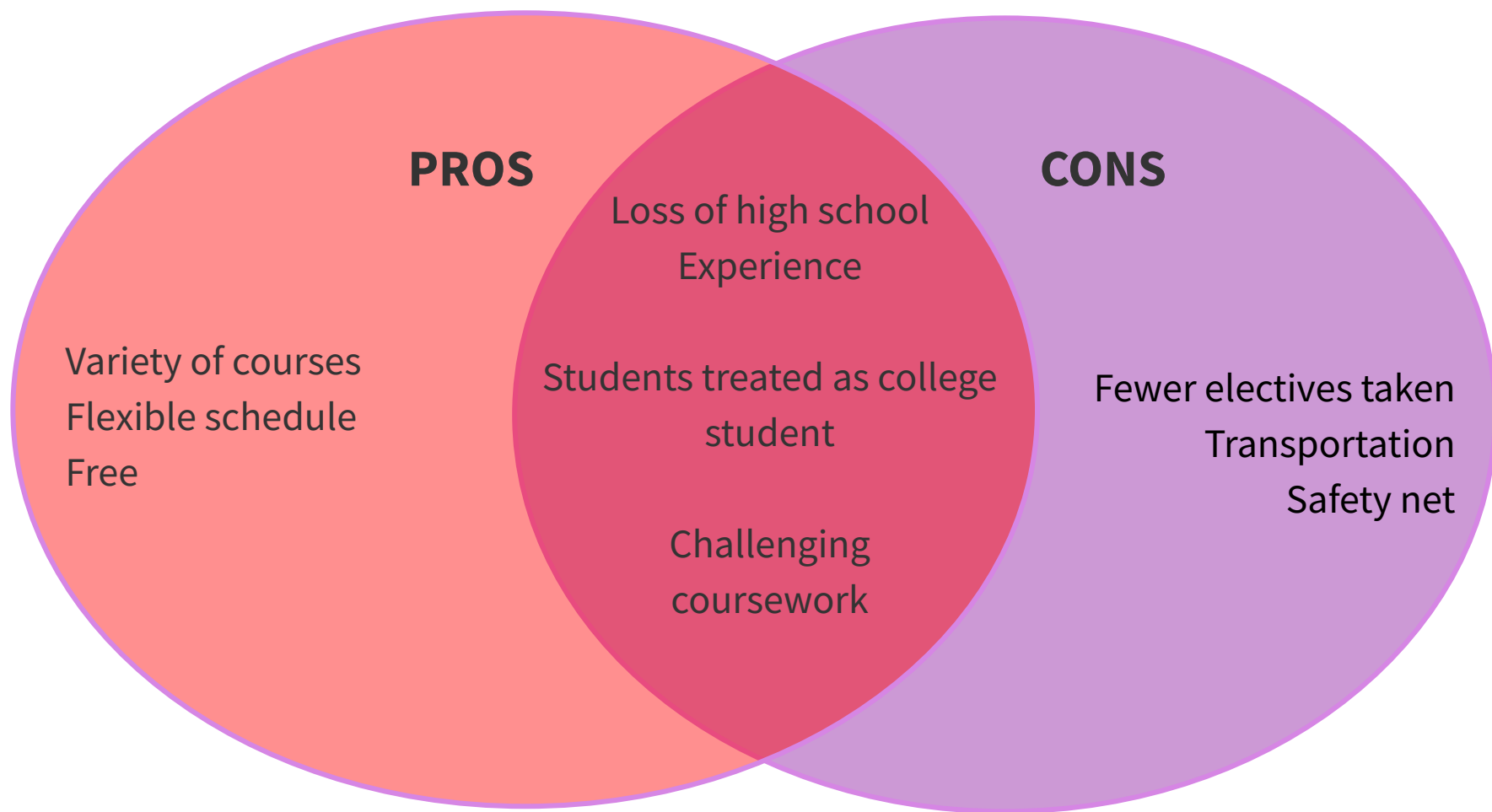

*Fees will apply if: a course requires equipment that a student will keep (i.e. tools); a course's supplemental fee is greater than \$85; the course is a developmental course

PSEO students are still High School students

- You must fulfill your high school graduation requirements *including* Program of Study
- Credits transfer 2 PSEO credits = 1 SHS credit
- We recommend aiming to complete the equivalent of 16 high school credits per year/8 credits per semester

PSEO students are still High School students

- For the Class of 2025
 - PSEO grades will be weighted if we offer a comparable course that is weight at SHS
 - Comparable course will only be weighted one time
- For the Class of 2026 & beyond
 - PSEO grades will be weighted if the same exact course is offered and weighted at Shakopee High School

PSEO students are still High School students

- Some high school requirements can be fulfilled with college courses
 - BIOL 1501 Principles of Biology = Biology credit
 - BIOL 1102 Human Biology ≠ Biology credit
 - Substitutions for required high school credits should be approved by your School Counselor
- Your Program of Study needs to be completed at Shakopee High School

PSEO students are still High School students

- PSEO courses are available to 10th, 11th, & 12th graders
- Courses for 10th graders are limited to CTE classes
 - 10th grade students can take only 1 course during their 1st semester

Full-time vs. Part-time

- Students are considered **full-time PSEO** students if they take 100% of their schedule through the PSEO institution
- Students are considered **part-time PSEO** students if they take some courses through both the PSEO institution and SHS
 - Part-time students need to have at least 1 block dedicated to PSEO in their schedule per quarter
 - Students cannot be scheduled for in-person or synchronous classes at the same time. They *must* create schedules that allow them to attend all classes with required attendance and allow for travel time if needed.
 - Part-time schedules are more complicated, but can work!

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Schedules do NOT align. This is particularly important if you are starting PSEO mid-year or are a part-time student!

Transferring Credits

- Many students use PSEO primarily to earn college credits and intend to transfer those credits to their college of choice after high school
 - Not all credits will transfer seamlessly between colleges
 - Transferology.com and college academic advisors can help you determine if/how credits will transfer
 - Contact your future college to ask about their transfer policies.
 - The MN Transfer Curriculum makes transferring credits within the MnSCU system easy

Credit Limits

- Students cannot take more than 18 credits per semester from a single college (dual enrollment + PSEO) or 22 credits total from multiple colleges without approval.
- Part-time PSEO students need to be aware of what dual enrollment credits they may be earning

2 Choose PSEO Institution

- Students can choose any participating school
 - Normandale Community College is the most popular school for SHS students
- Students are responsible for making sure they meet eligibility criteria and application deadlines

2 Choose PSEO Institution

Normandale Community College

SENIORS

- GPA 2.5 +
 - students with a GPA below 2.6 will need to demonstrate college-level reading by submitting ACT, SAT, or MCA score
- Top ½ of class
- 50th percentile or higher on a nationally normed test

JUNIORS

- GPA 3.0 +
- Top ⅓ of class
- 70th percentile or higher on a nationally normed test



Choose PSEO Institution

University of MN Twin Cities

- Minimum GPA 3.6* unweighted for general PSEO program (average GPA of admitted students is 3.94)
 - Minimum 2.0 GPA for American Indian Studies or School of Music options
- Feb 15, 2024 Application Opens
- April 15, 2024 Application deadline
- May 22, 2024 Decisions sent

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Submit Required Materials

1. Notice of Student Registration

- Students complete section 1 and email/deliver it to their school counselor
- Submit 1 form for every school to which you are applying
- Your counselor will return the form to you completed, you will submit this form and your transcript (found in Infinite Campus) to the college you're applying to

- Applications are found on the college's website

To participate in PSEO, attend a PSEO information meeting and apply directly to the college programs in which you are interested. Admission requirements vary from college to college.

Students participating in the PSEO program are responsible for choosing courses that will meet all the requirements for SHS graduation but should work closely with their counselors to make sure they are meeting graduation requirements.

Students who are part-time PSEO/SHS students, as well as students who begin PSEO mid-year, will often find that the end of the SHS quarter 2 overlaps with the beginning of the colleges' second semesters. Students must realize that they are still responsible for all the SHS coursework through the end of the quarter, and it is the student's responsibility to work directly with the SHS teacher(s) and college professors to resolve any conflicts.

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Follow Directions from PSEO

- **Check and read your emails**

- Colleges will email you decisions and directions for next steps
- Typical next steps include orientation, option to meet with an advisor, information on registering for classes, how to set up email

- **Shakopee School Counselors** are experts in high school graduation requirements, your credits, and our school.
- **College Advisors** are experts on the registration process at their school, their college courses, transferability of college courses ****We highly recommend meeting with an academic advisor at the college level****

Registering for Classes

- Students **MUST** complete the high school course registration process for next year
- Students **MUST** have all materials submitted by 5/30/24 if they plan to participate in PSEO for the 2024-25 school year (MN Statute 124D.09)

Registering for Classes

- The Shakopee High School schedule for the following year is not finalized until August, so we do not know which classes will be offered or what times classes will be offered until summer
 - Students should do their best to select courses that they think will work
- Once students have registered for college courses, they should send a copy of their schedule to their School Counselor.
 - In August, we will work to arrange their high school schedule around their college schedule the best we can. There is no guarantee this will work and sometimes difficult decisions need to be made.
