## 2016/2017 Open PTSA Positions

Northwest PTSA Board positions are open to any Northwest PTSA member and do not require previous board or PTSA experience. The PTSA currently has 2 elected positions open for nomination and 2 appointed positions. A summary description for each open position is listed below.

#### 2<sup>nd</sup> VP Membership – (elected)

Time Commitment: 1-3 hours per week at beginning of year; flattens out after October. Busiest Times of Year: September – November (Good job for parent working daytime hours) Coordinate membership drive: create membership envelopes for distribution, collect envelopes & record memberships in database. Collect, count, and deposit money with Treasurer.

## 3rd VP Fundraising - (elected)

Time Commitment: about 1-2 hours per month; more during peak times Busiest Times of Year: around major fundraisers. Assist with recruitment of and provide support to committee chairs for key fund-raising events. Coordinate and execute fundraising campaign, recruit volunteers as needed. Place vendor orders, advertise merchandise sales, organize and maintain inventory, submit invoices to Treasurer for reimbursement to vendors. Monitor results of fundraisers; align fundraising objectives and strategies with Northwest's budgetary needs and research other fundraising opportunities as required.

#### **Hospitality Chairperson** - (appointed)

Time Commitment: 3-5 hours per month. Busiest Times of Year: On-going, varies by event; Recruit committee of helpers and focus on making all parents feel welcome at Northwest. "Host" several events during the school year including a back-to-school lunch for school staff, Back to School Night/Open House, and teacher luncheons during holidays, conferences and at end of year. Coordinate Staff Appreciation Week events.

#### **Volunteer Coordinator** – (appointed)

Time Commitment: 3-5 hours per month Busiest Times of Year: On-going, varies by event. Coordinate parent volunteer pool at the beginning of the year for the various school events, both PTSA and school sponsored, by creating a volunteer interest form. Information gathered here may be used to form volunteer email lists for each event. Assist committee and event chairs in volunteer recruitment using various methods.
