

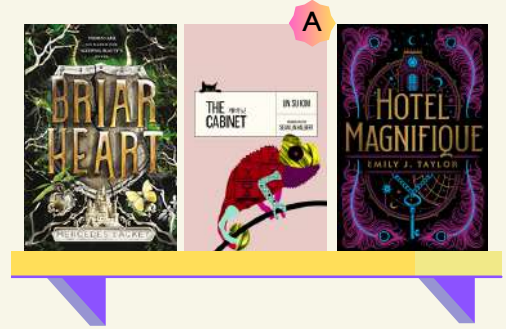
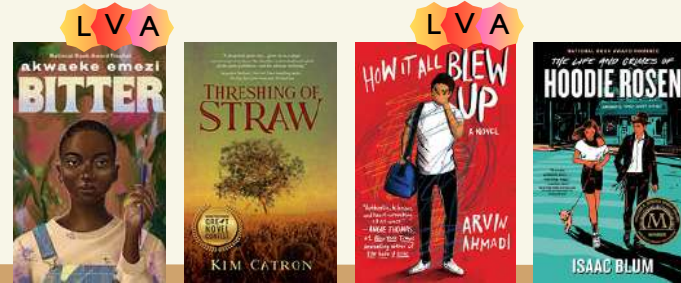
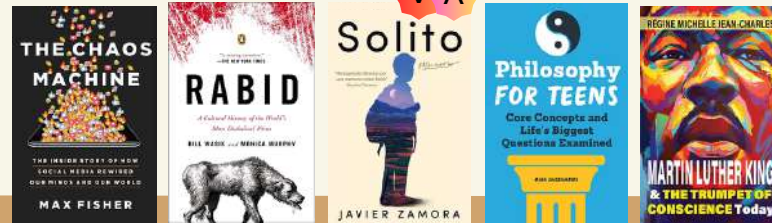
Peabody Veterans Memorial High School Summer Reading
