Welcome to General Music! This quarter we will be studying the elements of music. Throughout the quarter, we'll explore WHAT music is, WHY people create music, and HOW we as a musicians can express ourselves using sound.

What am I graded on?

<u>Song of the Day (90pts TOTAL):</u> each day, we will listen to a song, then write and discuss how the elements of music are working together to make "quality" music. Each day, we will add our thoughts in our SOD journals, then hand them in 5 at a time, totaling 30pts for 5 entries.

<u>Participation (5pts/day):</u> we are expected to work hard and act appropriately. This means that we'll keep an open mind, try our best, and work hard to make music class a safe and positive place.
