Qualities of a Good Research Paper

Top 10 Qualities

- 1. Successful papers stay tightly focused on their thesis, the point they are arguing.
- 2. The paper shows that the writer has a strong understanding of the topic and source material used.
- 3. The paper shows that the writer has read widely on the topic, including the works of recognized authorities in the field.

Top 10 Qualities

- 4. The paper includes an acknowledgement of the opposition but shows why the point being argued is more valid.
- 5. Proof for the paper's thesis is organized in a clear and logical way.
- 6. Each point is supported by solid, persuasive facts and by examples.
- 7. The work is original, not plagiarized. Every outside source is carefully documented.

Top 10 Qualities

- 8. All supporting material used in preparation of the paper can be verified.
- The paper follows a specific format, including the use of correct documentation and a Works Cited page.
- 10. The paper uses standard written English. This is the level of diction and usage expected of educated people in high schools, colleges, universities, and work settings.
