



Questions to ask your child during/after reading

These questions are to help cultivate comprehension skills. You don't have to ask your child all of these questions, choose three or more questions for each story. Try to have your child "echo" the question. For example, if you ask your child "Where does the story take place?" Your child should answer "The story takes place ____."

- What or who is the story mostly about?
- Where does the story take place?
- What part of the story did you like best?
- What did you learn from this story?
- What happened at the beginning, middle, and end of the story?
- Can you think of another ending for this story?
- How is this story like the one we read yesterday? How is it different?
- What would you do if you were the character in the story?
- Was this story fiction (fake) or nonfiction (not-fake/real)?
