#### 5. New Concept

#### Introduction

R blends: We learned that about CVC words. They have a consonant, vowel and then another consonant. Today, we are going to look at words that have a 4th sound. These words have 2 consonants before the vowel and we call them CCVC words. All of our words today are going to have the first consonant and then the 2<sup>nd</sup> one will always be the letter r. This is just like the I blends we did last time. Sometimes when you say the first 2 consonants at the same time, their sounds often blend together and it might be hard to hear the 2<sup>nd</sup> sound. Today, we will focus on paying attention to the 2<sup>nd</sup> sound /r/ in our reading and writing.

#### **Articulatory Gesture**

When we make the /r/ sound our tongue reaches up to the back of our top teeth. Now, I am going to leave the tongue touching the back of my teeth and turn on my voice box and feel the slight flow of air. This sound is continuous. We can hold the sound as long as we have air in our lungs.
