#### 2012 – 2013 School Year

Staffing Needs and Requests:
1.5 FTE <i>Elementary Special Education Teachers</i> \$ 72,000
Rationale: Both Robert Bennis Elementary and Fred Assam Elementary are
experiencing growth in caseloads so I may need to increase the FTE by .5 at
Fred Assam Elementary and add another full-time teacher at RBE for a total
of 2 FTEs at each school.
1.0 FTE <i>Nurse</i> \$45,000
Rationale: Currently we contract with an agency in Sioux Falls to provide
ndividualized nursing care to a student but it may be advantageous to employ
an additional nurse instead.
2.0 FTE Educational Assistants\$ 50,000
Rationale: The high school will need another educational assistant and
depending on new students needs, an additional educational assistant may
be needed in another building in the district.
