

# **ACCESS for ELLs Testing Window Extended**

# **Test Coordinator Training Registrations**

The RISAP Overview includes information applicable to all state assessments, including test security protocols, scheduling and location considerations, test administrator training, and similar. In addition, all test coordinators must attend one training session per state assessment they will coordinate (e.g., a high school test coordinator does not have to attend a RICAS session but should attend NGSA, PSAT10/SAT School Day, and DLM sessions; district test coordinators must attend one of each session). Each state assessment's session will include updates for Spring 2022, test administration protocols, technology, test design, and (DLM and PSAT10/SAT) accommodations and accessibility features. RICAS and NGSA accommodations and accessibility features will be discussed in detail during a separate webinar – register for the February 3 session from 10:00 to 11:30am.
