- Quote from the text, but don't let the quotes take over your response!
- Paraphrase as necessary.

Explain and Elaborate

- Explain your answer(s).
- Elaborate and make your answer longer.

Sum it up

- Conclude your answer/response.
- Link it to your topic sentence, but use different words than you did before.
