Requirements:

- 1. Only students in their senior year at Glidden-Ralston School and planning to attend a four-year post-secondary school are eligible to apply. (Student may also plan to attend a two-year community college as long as plans involve continuing on to a four-year school.)
- 2. Applicant must be pursuing a career in business or an area of computer science.
- 3. The scholarship recipient will be selected by a scholarship committee. It will be awarded based on 50% need, 25% GPA and 25% community service.
- 4. The scholarship will be paid to the school of the qualifying applicant. The qualifying applicant will receive \$500 each of the four years as long as the applicant continues to pursue the area of business or computer science and maintains a 2.5 GPA.
- 5. Scholarship recipient must show proof of continuing education in business or computer science by showing Glidden-Ralston School Counselor their schedule for the following semester.
- 6. Failure to continue the study in business or computer science will mean loss of scholarship.
- 7. Scholarship funds will be sent to the post-secondary school the beginning of the second semester when student provides a transcript of past classes and a copy of their schedule for the following semester.
- 8. The application must be turned in to the School Counselor by March 1.
