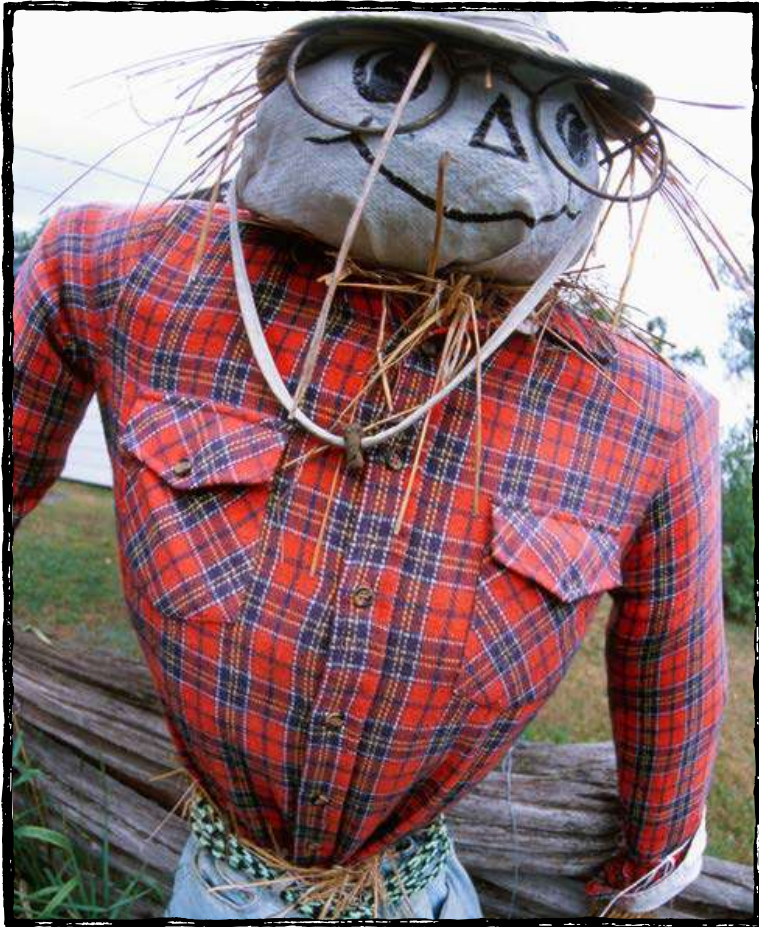

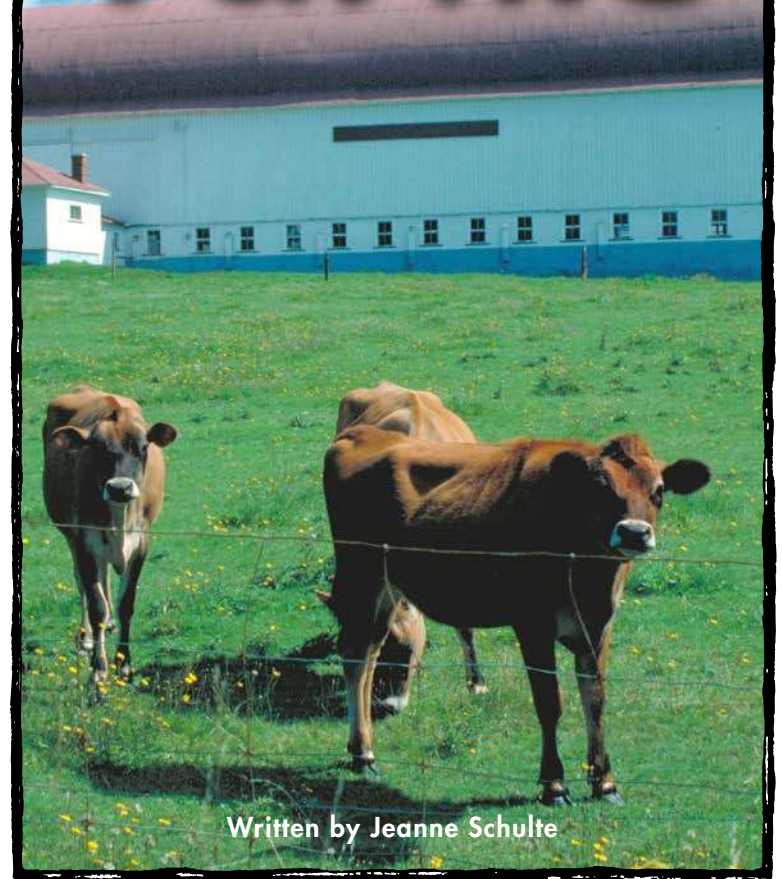

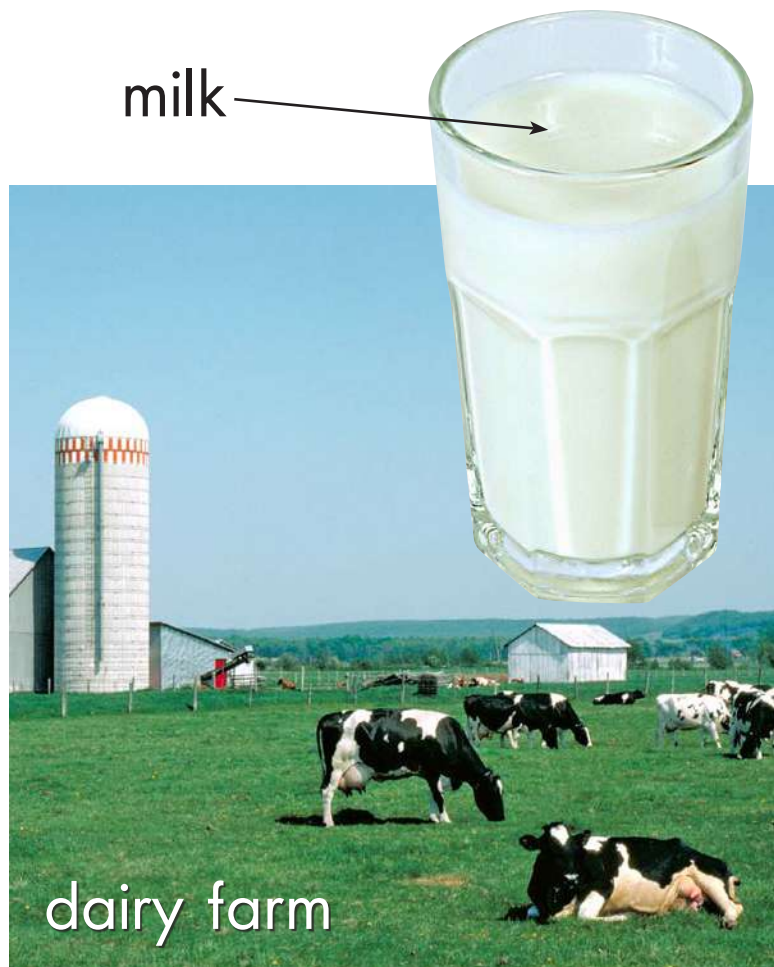

on farms, too.

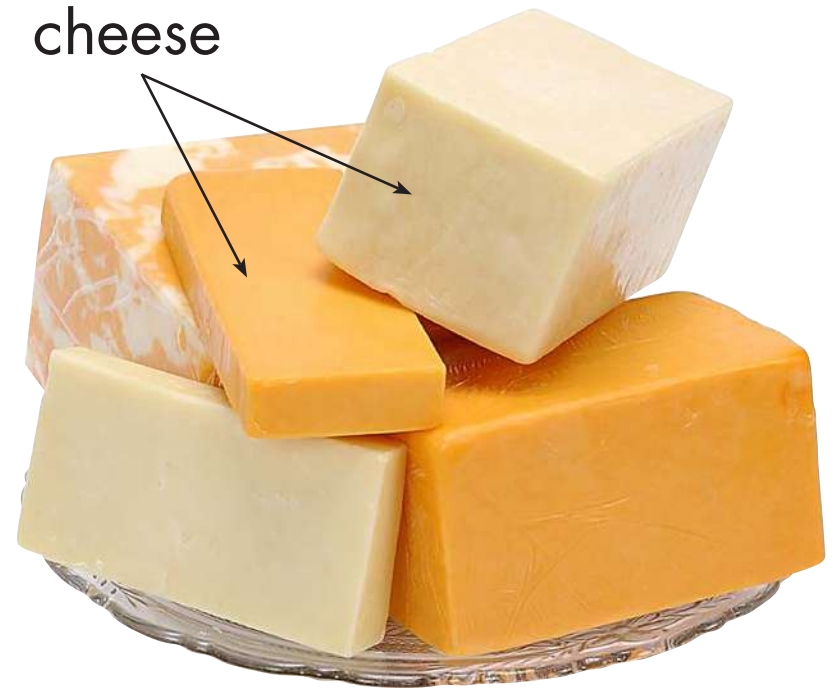
People eat fruits.



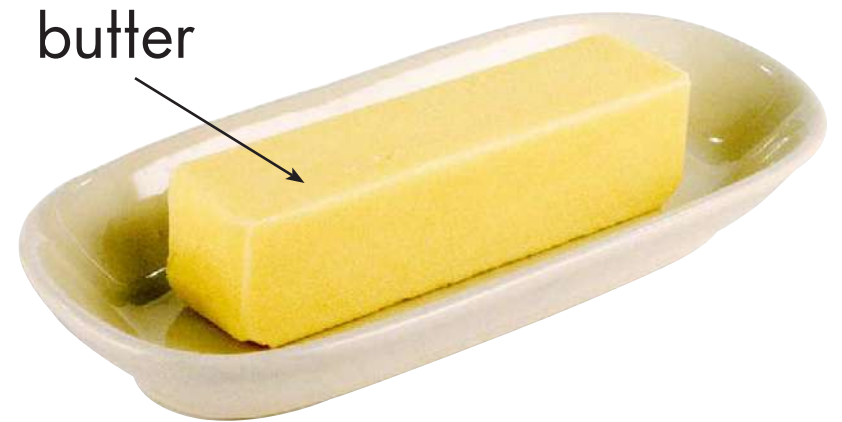

cheese



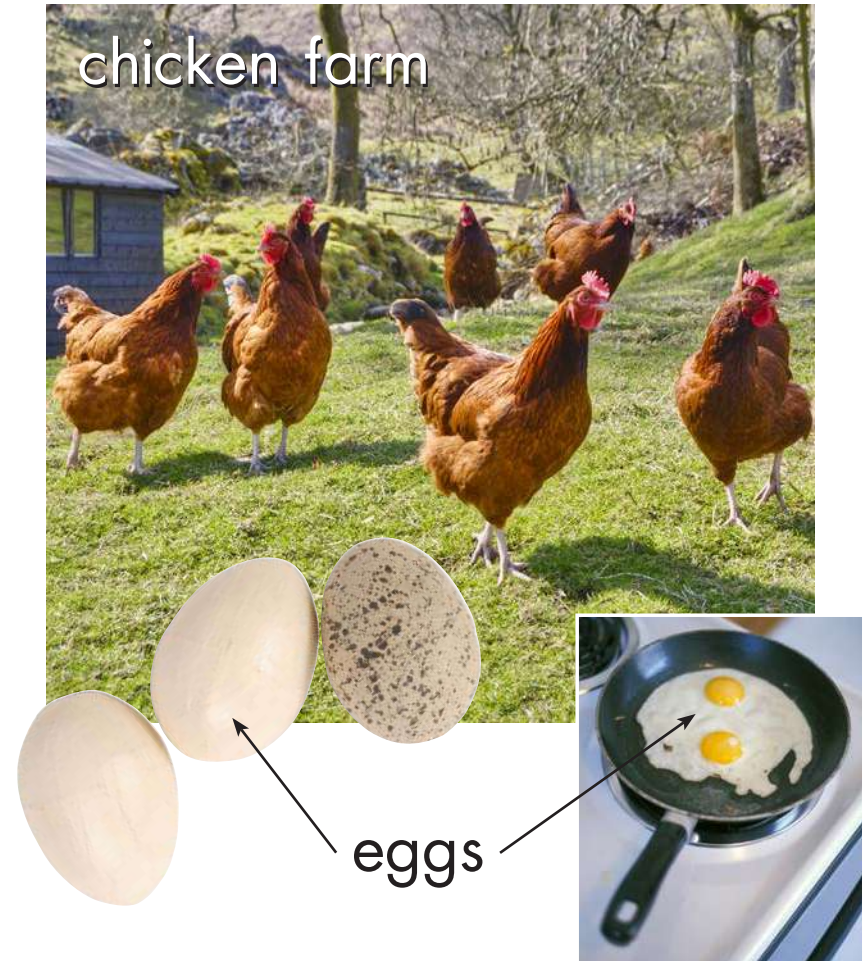
butter
