Content: Aligned to Common Core

As prescribed in Common Core Standards for English Language Arts Standard 10; Range, Quality and Complexity, Reading Literature Standards and Reading: Informational Text Standards, Reading Eggspress lessons build reading comprehension using:

Texts that increase in difficulty - Quantitative evaluation of the text. All Reading Eggspress texts have been independently levelled using the Lexile® Measure of text complexity and readability. The Assessment task results show growth in reading comprehension performance on texts with increasing Lexile levels across both fiction and nonfiction texts.

Content: Aligned to Common Core

A balance of fiction and nonfiction texts - Qualitative evaluation of the text: Levels of meaning, structure, language conventionality and clarity, and knowledge demands. Reading Eggspress texts are carefully chosen to include a balance of nonfiction and fiction texts including a wide range of narrative, poetry, drama and a range of informational text types.

Reading Literature and Informational texts - Ask and answer questions, read grade level texts, determine main idea and supporting details, determine meanings of words and phrases, summarise, interpret, purpose, inference, compare and contrast, point of view and structural analysis are all covered in the lessons. The Maps

Each map is unique in its design to match the content of the Focus Book. Using a visual progress format is highly motivating for students.



In this map the design reflects it is a book set in India with the key characters.

Focus Books

The 44 Focus Books (one for each map) have been carefully chosen to include a wide range of stories, poetry, topics and high interest nonfiction texts. These increase in complexity as students build reading comprehension skills and their love of reading.

Each map contains 5 lessons, a focus book and an assessment task.

This shows a sample from an informational map. Each lesson focuses on an extract from a range of quality nonfiction titles. The focus book gives students the opportunity to read a number of chapters on the same topic. The Assessment task assesses each student's comprehension skills using an unseen informational text. Literature maps use a range of fiction extracts and students read a complete book.



Comprehension Lesson Components



Lesson: Pre-reading activities

In each lesson, five pre-reading activities build a range of comprehension strategies, including: activating prior knowledge, word study, cause and effect and main idea and details.



Lesson: Read and answer questions about the text

Students carefully read the extract and then answer a quiz with a range of literal, inferential, vocabulary and whole text questions. Students receive instant feedback about correct and incorrect answers. Students who redo the quiz will see a different set of questions.



Lesson: Earn a reward

Students earn a trading card and golden eggs for completing the quiz.



Lesson: Read a chapter of a book

Students read a chapter of the focus book and answer a short quiz. This is the end of the lesson and students earn another trading card.



Progress

Maps with numbered lessons are highly motivating proof of progress for students. Assessment result graphs show students how much they have improved over time.



Reports

Teachers can access powerful reports that show strengths and weaknesses of both students and the whole class.



Assessment

At the end of five lessons, students complete an assessment task. This 10 question test assesses student understanding of a levelled passage.



In Map 20, the assessment passage is The Moon, Lexile 790.

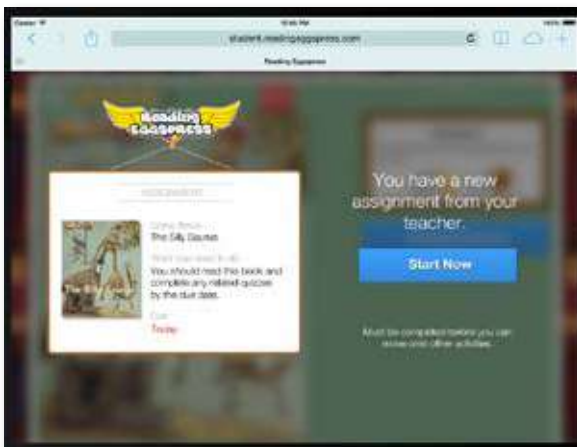
