What is Good to Go Kids?

Good to Go Kids is a community-based organization made up of volunteers. It is not connected to or run by the school district. It operates under the umbrella of a 501.C3 non-profit, the Carver Scott Educational Foundation.



Why was it established?

Shakopee School Board member Mary Romansky established Good to Go Kids in 2012 to help ensure students get the nutrition they need to keep their minds and bodies active and healthy. There are children who leave school and return to homes with little or no food. Students who have full stomachs can concentrate more on their studies when they are not worrying about where or when their next meal will come. The program is based on the fact that healthy and nutritional food helps students learn better and have better attendance.

How does it work?

Every Friday, students in the Good to Go Kids program in several participating Shakopee schools can pick up a backpack at a designated area in their school. The backpacks will already be filled with food, such as bread, peanut butter, cereal, granola bars, rice, beans, macaroni and cheese, etc., ready for them to take home. They return the backpack to school the following week.

How can a student qualify for Good to Go Kids?

All students who qualify for the federal Free/Reduced Lunch Program can be accepted into the Good to Go Kids program. But that is not a requirement. The program will accept any student in need of help. Families enrolled in the Free/Reduced Lunch Program receive a letter about Good to Go Kids and have the opportunity to opt in to participate.

The bag may contain items such as peanut butter, juice, bread, crackers, soup, etc. Children bring the bag home for the weekend.




