The scholarships we offer, therefore, will be given to those who show greatest inclination to serve their community and world. So we ask you, as you apply for this scholarship, to state how you have served in your high school years and how you plan to serve in the future.

All are eligible to receive this scholarship to help pay for postsecondary education—without regard to race, creed, gender, location of school or affiliation to any Lions Club. Redfield Lions will annually present up to two scholarships of \$300 each to be paid during the students’ second semester of postsecondary education.

To apply for our scholarship, please submit a 1-2 page application to the Redfield High School Guidance Counselor **by April 5th, 202** providing this information:

1. Your name
2. Your birthdate
3. Your address, phone number and email address
4. Names of your parent(s) or guardian(s)
5. Your plans for education beyond high school

In keeping with our motto, “We Serve,” the Lions members who choose the scholarship winners will judge based on the following responses:

6. Tell us ways in which you have served others through your school, your church, your clubs, and your community involvement. Please be as specific as possible.
7. Tell us what you have learned from your experience of serving other people and how your service to others has benefited or changed you.
8. Tell us about the career you are pursuing and how you see yourself serving your neighbors and community through that career and by other efforts in your adult life.
9. Share anything else you want us to consider as we review your application.
