This year marks the 49<sup>th</sup> year of the <u>Superintendent's High School Art Show</u>. This annual event sponsored by the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI) celebrates the arts and showcases artistic excellence demonstrated by high school students in Washington. Artworks submitted by all nine of the state's educational service districts (ESDs) are entered into the Superintendent's High School Art Show. These pieces are reviewed and scored for statewide awards and recognition including a \$200 cash prize and a trophy. To participate in the Superintendent's High School Art Show, students must be nominated by a Regional High School Art Show (must participate in a Regional High School Art Show). The Washington Art Education Association (WAEA) is a key partner in this annual event.
