We also ask that you put an "A" beside two alternate electives (in the event your first choice is unavailable

(Note: When making class selections, please do not select basic unless your child has an IEP that supports the choice)

- (2) The course selection form can be mailed back to Northwest
- (3) The course selection form can be dropped off at Northwest Mon Thurs from 9am to 2pm

Course selection forms need to be returned/information in Powerschool by May 15, 2020
