

Forest Hills High School Registration 2020-2021

What do you need to know?

It's time to register for next year's classes! Registration for the 2020-2021 school year will be done online. This is what **YOU** will need to do in order to be ready for registration with a counselor beginning on March 16th. We encourage students to discuss their course requests with their parents or guardians.

- 1. Review the registration power point that is posted on the Forest Hills website if you'd like.
- 2. Log into your Student Portal. Click on <u>Grade History</u>-at the top are tabs for each school year. Review past high school years to see what courses you have already passed and determine what courses you still need.

**The following courses must be passed in order to graduate from Union County
Public Schools:

English I	Math I	World History	Earth & Env. Science
English II	Math II	Civics & Econ	Biology
English III	Math III	American History I	Physical Science or
English IV	4 th math	American History II	Chemistry or Physics

Health/PE And 6 non-PE electives

- 3. Next Click on Course Registration on the Left Hand side of the page and then click on the pencil in each section to make your course selections for next year.
 - a. You must pick 8 classes (including required classes and electives) and 3 alternates in order to save your course selections. In order to make selections simply click on the pencil, make your choices and then hit SUBMIT. <u>If you do not choose 8 classes and 3 alternates it will NOT save.</u>
 - b. Choose classes that are the SAME level as what you are currently taking.

For example, if you are currently taking CP level, choose CP classes. If you want a different level, you can discuss with a counselor when you meet during registration. Please note: If you plan to take CCP classes, you should still choose the required classes that you need to graduate. For example, American History 2 or English 4. If you plan to graduate mid-year, you will still need to select 8 courses & 3 alternates. You cannot choose TA or Peer Tutor since you must complete an application for these.

- c. You must complete your Course Selections before you can meet with a counselor to finalize your courses.
- **4.** Beginning March 16th, students will be called to the Media Center by homeroom (starting with 11th graders) during 1st, 2nd or 4th block to review their course selections with a counselor and to make modifications where appropriate based on teacher and counselor recommendations. Registration will be held on the following dates:

 March 16, 18, 27, 30 and April 1, 3, and 6.

Counselors will NOT meet with students until they have completed their course selections in Power School. PLEASE have this done BEFORE March 16th.
