- ➤ <u>ASB MEMBERSHIP/ID CARD</u>: \$45 For all students, Associated Student Body membership provides paper & toner supplies to students for printing, student networking & wi-fi, and student printer/computer repairs. Additional technology is available to students such as: laptop check out, digital photo & video recorders, memory devices, 3D printer, Kindles, iPads, and iPods. These items enhance WLHS student learning by offering the advantage of accessing, learning, and experiencing a variety of technologies. In addition, an ASB ID Card allows free entry to all regular-season athletic events at <u>all</u> Three Rivers League schools. ASB builds student community by supporting student-directed events, clubs, inspirational speakers, and student-produced media. Pick up your ID card before you leave the gym on Picture Day!
- ➤ <u>OUTSTANDING FEES & FINES</u>: Please check your student's account online in FamilyLink under, "Student Fees." Fees marked in parenthesis are credits on account. *Do not include lunch balances*. Lunch balances must be sent to the District Nutrition Services Department at 2755 SW Borland Rd, Tualatin, OR 97062.
- > <u>2019 YEARBOOK</u>: \$40 *Summer registration special*—reserve your yearbook now, and pay only \$40! The price will be \$50 after September 1st. Reserve a copy now for a beautiful, award-winning yearbook while supplies last!
- DISTRICT ACTIVITY FEE: \$225 All students in drama productions, cheer team, dance team, and intramural basketball are required to pay this fee prior to participation. If this fee is prohibitive, please contact the bookkeeper to discuss payment plan, fee waiver, or scholarship options. If your student will be involved in an activity above *and* athletics, pay only the Athletic Fee (below) do not pay both.
- ➤ <u>DISTRICT ATHLETIC FEE</u>: **1 sport** = \$300; **2 sports** = \$350; **3 sports** = \$375 See reverse for sports that require this fee. If your student will be involved in athletics *and* an activity, pay only the Athletic Fee do not pay both.
- ➤ PARENT PRIDE: \$25 The WLHS parent club supports all students through community event funding, technical support, scholarship funds for students in need, and programs and equipment for student activities. A \$25 donation is greatly appreciated! Sign up for volunteer opportunities on our website at WLHS> About > Volunteering.
- **PSAT: \$18** (*Wednesday, October 10, 2018*) **Only Juniors pay this fee.** All college-bound Juniors should register for the PSAT as it provides practice for the SAT and qualifies juniors for National Merit Scholarships.

Sophomores are required to take the PSAT and are automatically registered, free of charge. **Freshmen & Seniors** do not come to school on this day.

- NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY: \$20 For qualifying & accepted Juniors & Seniors (3.5 GPA + application & essay).
- SENIOR PARKING PERMIT: \$40 This is for Seniors only. See the Students > Seniors page of our website for requirements, deadlines, and application. Include this fee in your payment if your student met the June parking application deadline. Parking hangers will be distributed only when ASB, parking permit, and all past fees (i.e. lost books) have been paid.
- > <u>SENIOR DEDICATION AD</u>: Prices vary. See flyer or visit: www.wlhsyearbook.com for more information. You may include payment for a Senior Dedication Ad with registration fees. Send ads/photos directly to yearbook by October 31st.
- AP EXAM FEES: Students enrolled in AP classes are required to take the corresponding AP exam(s). Each exam will cost \$93 (price may change). Do not pay with fall reg. fees. Email notification will be sent when charges post in February, and are due in March.
- ➤ LOST BOOK/EQUIPMENT FEES: Students are responsible for each book and piece of equipment checked out to them. The exact copy that was checked out to a student is due back from that student, or fines will be incurred. Turning in a different copy of a textbook will not clear the fee. Please discuss with your student the importance of keeping track of their books. WLHS will charge for lost and damaged textbooks, uniforms, electronics, and overdue books. Your student can avoid these charges by keeping track of books and equipment, returning them undamaged and on time. Textbook replacement costs range from \$50-\$230; technology replacement costs range from \$30-\$1,000; and uniform replacement costs range from \$50-\$300. Per ORS 339.260, a school district may withhold grades, diplomas and records of any student who owes a debt. In addition, students may be barred from extra-curricular activities until fees are paid. If a fee is incurred, email notification will be sent to each student and parent on a monthly basis. Do not delay in paying fees as it may delay a student's participation in activities. We offer monthly payment plans, fee waivers or scholarships for exceptional circumstances. Payment plans must be adhered to in order for a student's account to remain in good standing and sports/activity clearances to be allowed.
