What is a Verified Credit?

- A verified credit is awarded for a course in which the student successfully completes the requirements of the course AND achieves a passing score on the SOL test for that course.
- Example: Pass Earth Science class & pass Earth Science SOL

All students must take the Biology SOL, as well as 1 math SOL while in high school. Once a student has completed their verified credit requirements, they will not take any more SOL tests, even if they are enrolled in a SOL class.

Athletic Eligibility

- A student must pass 3 of the 4 classes from the previous semester, and also be enrolled in at least 3 classes the current semester.



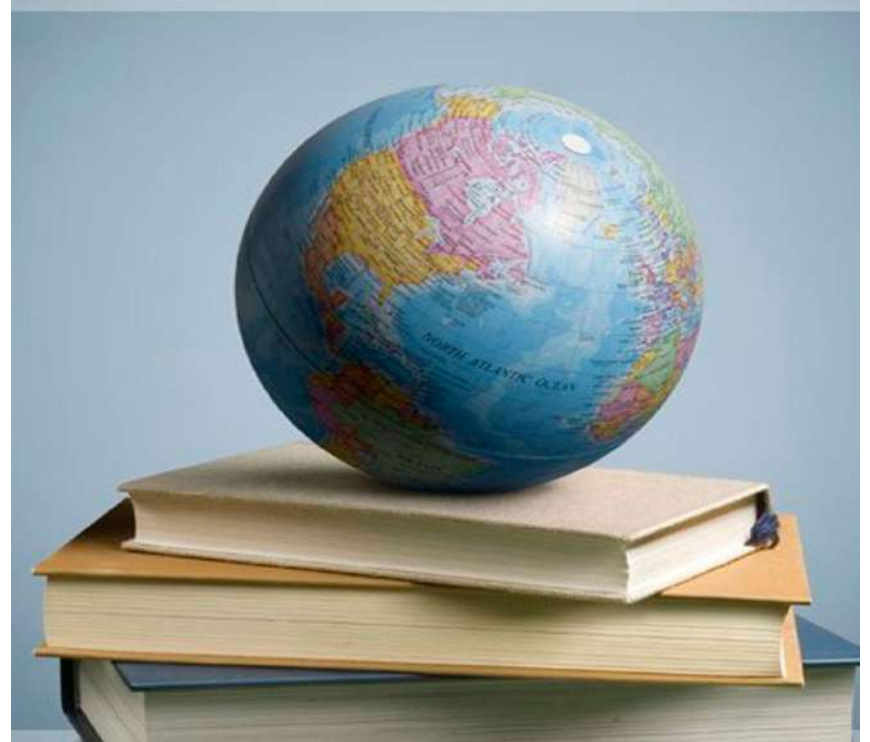

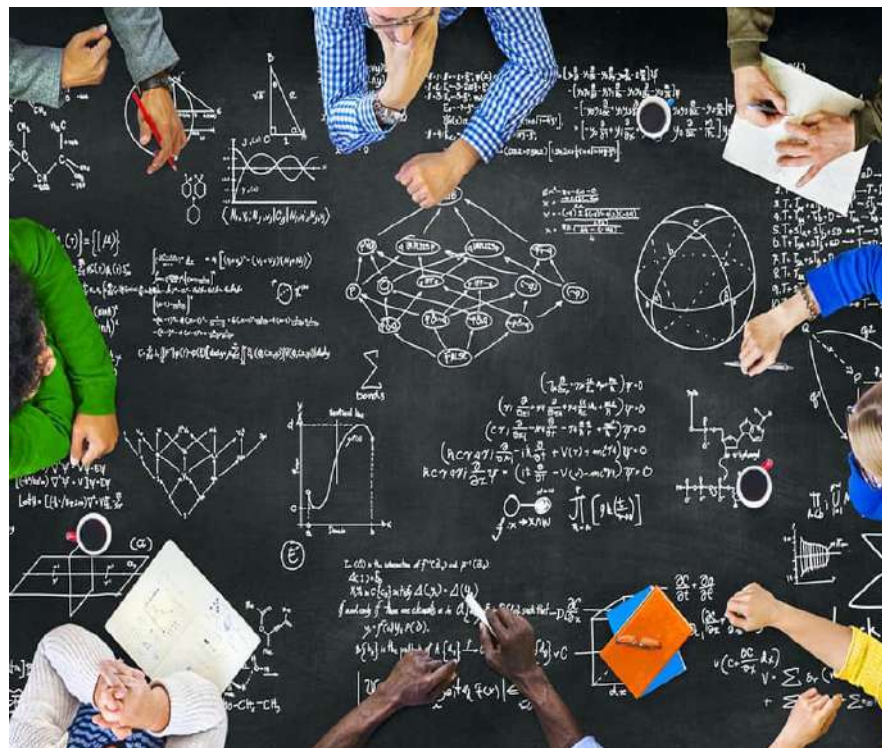

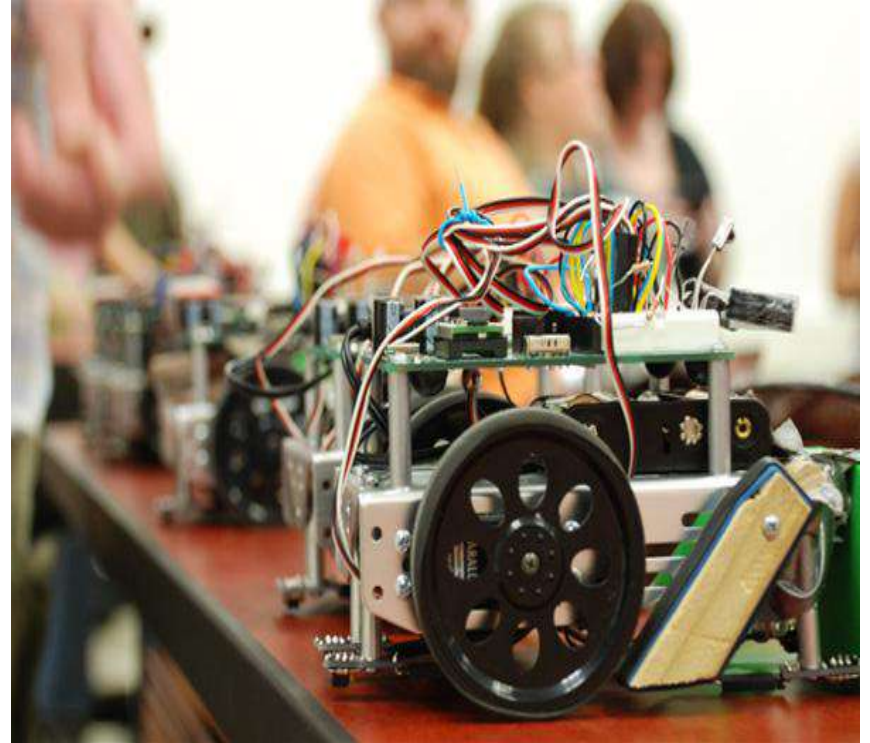

Work Based Learning

- Must be enrolled in CTE course during school year
- Application completed
- Employment begins by first day of school and is maintained throughout the school year.
- Seniors are able to get 2 blocks off each semester, if their schedule permits.
- This program is a full year program worth 1 credit.

Credit for Work-Based Learning during a 36-week school year will be based upon successful completion of the course and continuous employment throughout the school year, averaging between 11-15 hours a week.

- Student receives both high school and college credit.
 - Tuition rates are determined by the community colleges and will be announced to students and parents as soon as the information is made available to the school division.
 - Dual enrollment tuition can be paid on schedule pick up days, and must be paid on or before the last drop day for LB classes by semester.

Dual Enrollment Opportunities

- Students will have the opportunity to take dual enrollment courses at VWCC, as long as the courses can be applied to a degree or certificate program. Students will be responsible for knowing registration deadlines and paying tuition directly to Virginia Western.
- Student receives both high school and college credit.
- A student **MUST** meet with their high school counselor **PRIOR** to enrolling in a dual enrollment course at VWCC.

VA Placement Test

- If a student is taking a dual enrollment class at VWCC, they **may** need to take VPT to be eligible for their class. The VPT must be taken at VWCC. Scores must be received by your School Counselor before the start of the new school year. Please see the VWCC website for more information.
- SAT and ACT scores **MAY** qualify a student to opt out of the VPT. Please check with your School Counselor about your specific score requirements.

Electives

Electives

- Elective requests should be classes a student is excited to take, including alternate choices!
- There is a strong chance a student might end up in an alternate course and they will have to take that course.
- Schedules changes will NOT be made out of a requested elective course, including alternates.

Schedule Changes

- Change from one course to another will be made only under the following circumstances:
 - Failure of a course which is a prerequisite for a scheduled course or a graduation requirement
 - Human or computer error
 - Change in program of studies
 - No move between course levels will be made after the 1st five weeks of a class

Registration Process

- Students will complete registration through a grade level specific google form.
- Students will NOT have to complete registration in PowerSchool like they have in years past.
- Students will receive a copy of their google form responses through their 1770 account.
- The registration form can only be filled out ONCE.
- If a student needs to make changes after they have submitted their form, they need to email their specific School Counselor.

Registration is due by February 1st.

Changes in initial course selection cannot be made after July 1st. Please see pg. 13 in our Program of Studies for more information on this policy.
