
## Athletic Eligibility







## Work Based Learning

- ➤ Must be enrolled in CTE course during school year
- > Application completed
- > Employment begins by first day of school and is maintained throughout the school year.
- > Seniors are able to get 2 blocks off each semester, if their schedule permits.
- > This program is a full year program worth 1 credit.

Credit for Work-Based Learning during a 36-week school year will be based upon successful completion of the course and continuous employment throughout the school year, averaging between 11-15 hours a week.

- Tuition rates are determined by the community colleges and will be announced to students and parents as soon as the information is made available to the school division.
- Dual enrollment tuition can be paid on schedule pick up days, and <u>must</u> be paid on or before the last drop day for LB classes by semester.

#### **Dual Enrollment Opportunities**

- > Students will have the opportunity to take dual enrollment courses at VWCC, as long as the courses can be applied to a degree or certificate program. Students will be responsible for knowing registration deadlines and paying tuition directly to Virginia Western.
- > Student receives both high school and college credit.
- > A student MUST meet with their high school counselor PRIOR to enrolling in a dual enrollment course at VWCC.

## VA Placement Test

- ➤ If a student is taking a dual enrollment class at VWCC, they \*may\* need to take VPT to be eligible for their class. The VPT must be taken at VWCC. Scores must be received by your School Counselor <u>before</u> the start of the new school year. Please see the VWCC website for more information.
- > SAT and ACT scores \*MAY\* qualify a student to opt out of the VPT. Please check with your School Counselor about your specific score requirements.

## Schedule Changes

  - Failure of a course which is a prerequisite for a scheduled course or a graduation requirement
  - Human or computer error
  - Change in program of studies
  - No move between course levels will be made after the 1<sup>st</sup> five weeks of a class
