eLearning and Remote Learning Information

### **Expectations**:

**eLearning** - Students are expected to log in at the designated time that the teacher has specified. Attendance will be taken daily. Students are expected to complete assignments as directed by the teacher. Parents will be notified if their student is not logging in and keeping up with assignments. After two days of a student not logging into class and/or not completing assignments, the teacher will be in contact with the parent.

**Remote Learning** - if all students must go to Remote Learning, as directed by the state or county, we understand that some students will not have daily access to the internet. Students who are unable to attend classes via Schoology as scheduled should make every effort to check in daily for assignments, Schoology Conference recordings, teacher provided videos, and announcements. Access points are available at public libraries, our school (can use from parking lot), and other locations.

#### eLearning / Remote Schedule:

\*These practices will apply if there are no in-person classes due to the state colorcoding. Students will follow the same daily schedule for eLearning, or Remote Learning, as they would if they were learning "In Person."

Students begin the day with Homebase / 1st Period at 8:00 AM.

Students will have their 4 CORE classes (English, mathematics, social studies, and science) and 1 Related Arts (Music, Art, Wellness, Reading, etc.) class each day, Monday - Friday.

There will be a break at mid day for lunch. Feeding program information will come from Kanawha County Schools.

The school day ends at 2:45 PM.

### Grading:

#### Important to note.....

This year is NOT like the Spring and there are requirements and expectations that have to be maintained.

EMS will utilize the Kanawha County School grading scale. Grading periods occur every nine weeks and will be announced on the school calendar. Semester grades will post in January and June. Students must pass six of eight core content classes in order to be eligible for promotion.

#### Grade Scale:

- A 90-100%
- B- 80-89%
- C- 70-79%
- D- 60-69%
- F-Below 60%

## Student Responsibilities:

Dedicate appropriate time to learning, as guided by the lessons provided by your teachers.

- Check Schoology messages and ALL Schoology courses daily for updates, or have your parents help you.
- Set up a study space that is comfortable where you can study and learn.
- Submit all assignments before, or by, their due dates.

• Communicate via Schoology message, or email, with teachers regarding any problems you are having with assignments and/or technology, or have your parents email the teacher.

• If you are having trouble with your device, refer to the Kanawha County Schools' district website for instructions to obtain assistance.

• Set goals for learning and practice good time management skills.

- Remember to practice digital citizenship at all times.
- Be patient, work hard, and be kind!

# Parent Responsibilities:

Support your child in their learning by:

- Encouraging adherence to all eLearning/remote learning assignments.
- Designating a place where your child can work independently and with few distractions.

• Asking your child about his/her assignments to further engage them in the learning.

Checking with your child to ensure assignments are completed by due dates.

- Reminding your child to Schoology message, or email his/her teacher if they have any questions, or need support in their learning.
- Schoology message, or emailing teachers, with questions when you need assistance.
- Regularly checking the EMS Schoology page, checking Schoology Update pages for all courses, and checking the website for important information and updates.
