Logging-in To Your Arts High School Chromebook

- 2. You will need your Student ID #, and Student Network Password to use as your log-in credentials

Obtaining Your PowerSchool Schedule

- 1. Use your parent/guardian's credentials to log-in to PowerSchool
 - a. The PowerSchool Log-in credentials are assigned to the parent/guardian, not the student
 - b. New students received an email with PowerSchool Log-in credentials (most recently on 9/3/20)
 - c. If you do not have PowerSchool log-in credentials, please contact AHS parent liaison Davonne Salley <u>D1Salley@nps.k12.nj.us</u>
- 2. Locate your PowerSchool class schedule, and print/save/copy
- 3. This schedule consists of 9 periods, including lunch, and tells you during which period of the regular school day each of your classes would meet.

Determining Days/Times When Your Classes Meet Remotely

- 1. Go to the Arts High School website <u>www.artshighschool.org</u>
- 2. On the homepage, just below the image carousel, click on <u>Remote Learning Schedule Fall 2020</u>
- 3. This document tells you on which day and time each of your classes will actually meet remotely.
- 4. Please Note Since school begins on Tuesday, September 8th, your homeroom will meet at 8:40, and then you will start with Period 5 at 8:50.

Your Google Classrooms

- 1. Your Google Classrooms for each class have been populated in your NBOE district Google account automatically, based on your PowerSchool schedule. This process updates daily, so if your schedule changes, so will the Google Classrooms in your account.
