1. <u>Introducción</u>: You and your partner will research a dish from any Spanish speaking region of the world. In your research, you must find the answer the all of the following questions, and write them in one paragraph using complete Spanish sentences:

- (2)b. ¿Cómo es la comida? (described with details using adjectives)
- (2)c. ¿Es buena para la salud o mala para la salud? ¿Por qué? (is healthy)
- (2)d. ¿De dónde es la comida?(origen,country,city)

2. <u>La receta</u>: After researching a particular dish, you must write out a 5 (minimum) to 10(maximum) step recipe telling exactly how one makes this food.

- \_\_\_\_(5) a. ingredientes (minimum 5 ingredients)
- (5) b. 5 steps (how to make it) or 8 steps (extra 2 points).
- (5) c. You must conjugate each verb. (use commands and se impersonal)
  - (5) d. Make sure to use ordinal numbers (primero, segundo, etc.) and adverbs (entonces, luego,etc) to explain the order in which you take each step or add each ingredient.

## 3. <u>La presentación</u>: present your recipe to the world when you are on air.
