



- Students must submit an original 150 word essay in French telling us about themselves
 and why it would be meaningful to be inducted into this society. If there is doubt as to
 the originality of the student composition submitted, the application will be withdrawn.
 The essay will not be graded or based on grammatical structures but rather content.
 Therefore we strongly encourage the students to take the time to reflect on the
 experience of learning French and how the study of the language has impacted them.
- Students must submit this form with their name, their final grades in French for 9th, 10th and 11th grade, and their teacher's name and signature. Students must have a final grade of an A or A- in the 9th, 10th, and 11th grades. If a student has been in an honors French class at any point, he/she may include the weighted average for the class.
- Students will be considered based on their grade average, their love of language, their character and their contribution to the school community.
- As members of Société Honoraire de Français, students must continue the study of
 French in their Senior Year. If a student chooses to withdraw from his / her French class
 at any point during their senior year, membership in the Honor Society will be rescinded
 immediately.
