

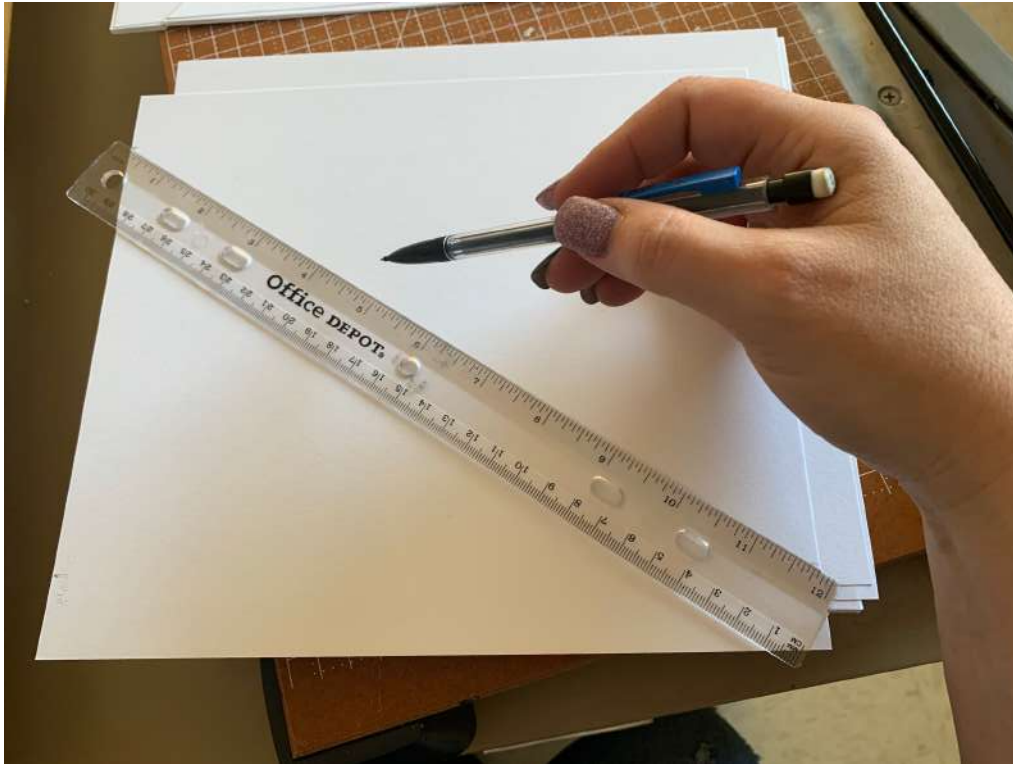
Start with an  $8 \frac{1}{2} \times 11$  piece  
of cardstock

Cut the long side down to  $9 \frac{1}{8}$ "

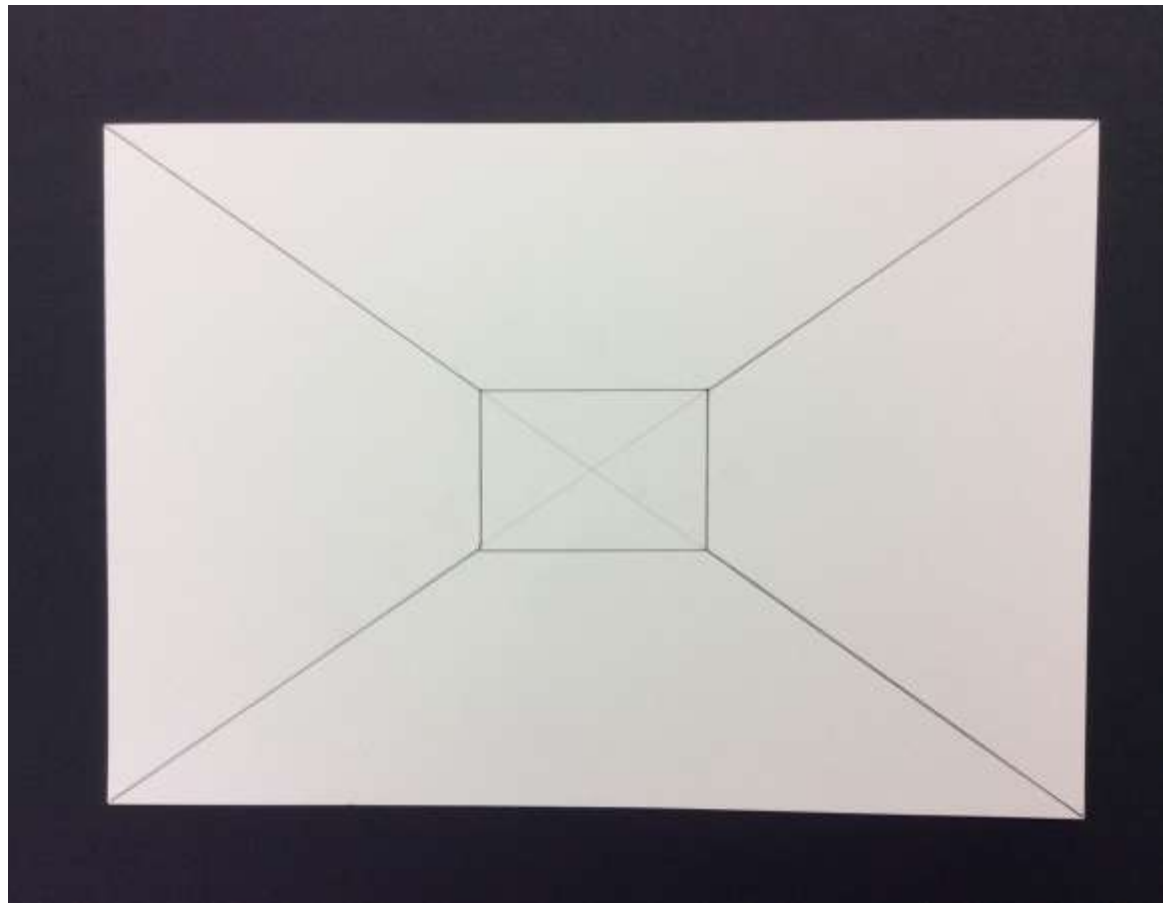
- Make 8 marks around your paper, one inch from each corner.
- There will be two marks on each side.

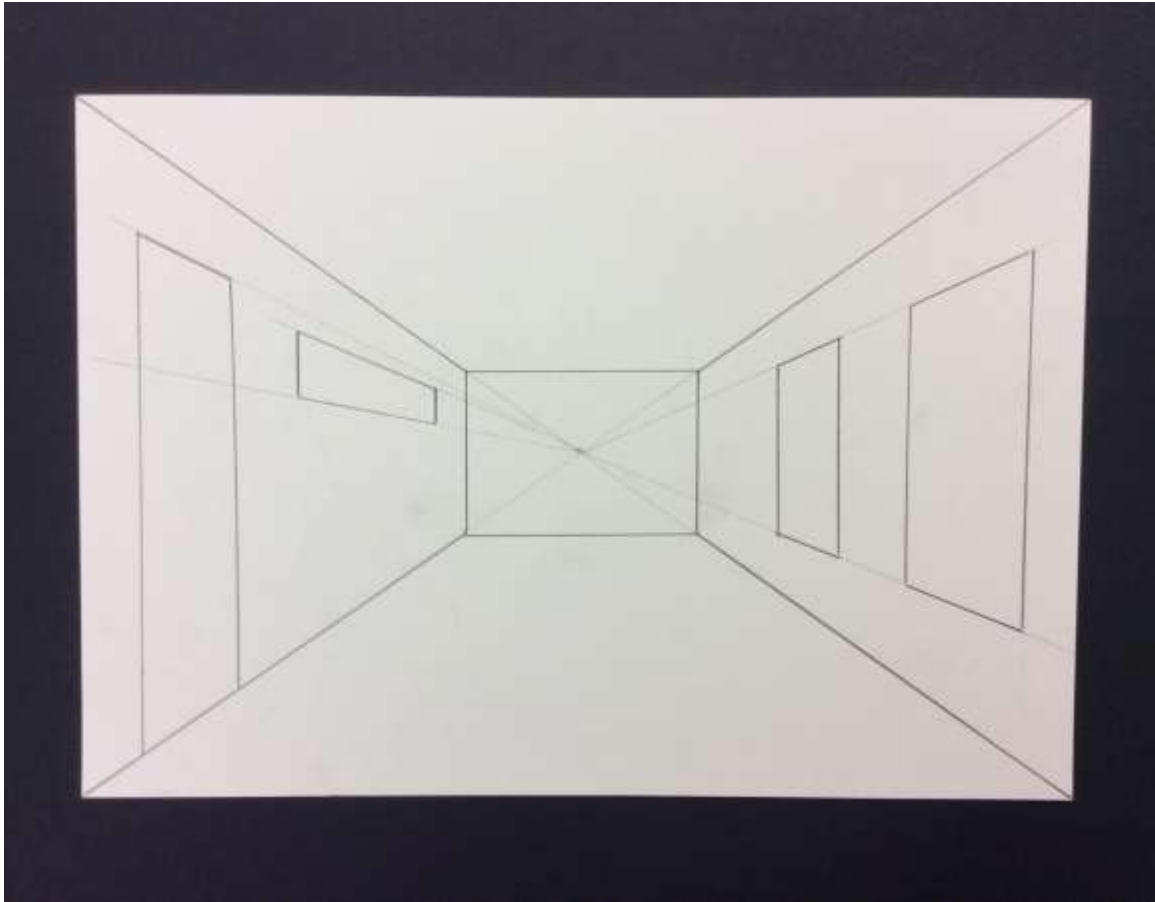


- Set your paper in LANDSCAPE format: ☐
- Use your ruler and 2H pencil.
- Draw a line from your top left mark to your bottom right mark.
- Draw a line from your top right mark to your bottom left mark.

This will make an X.

With your regular pencil  
and a ruler, make a 2"x3"  
rectangular box in the  
center.

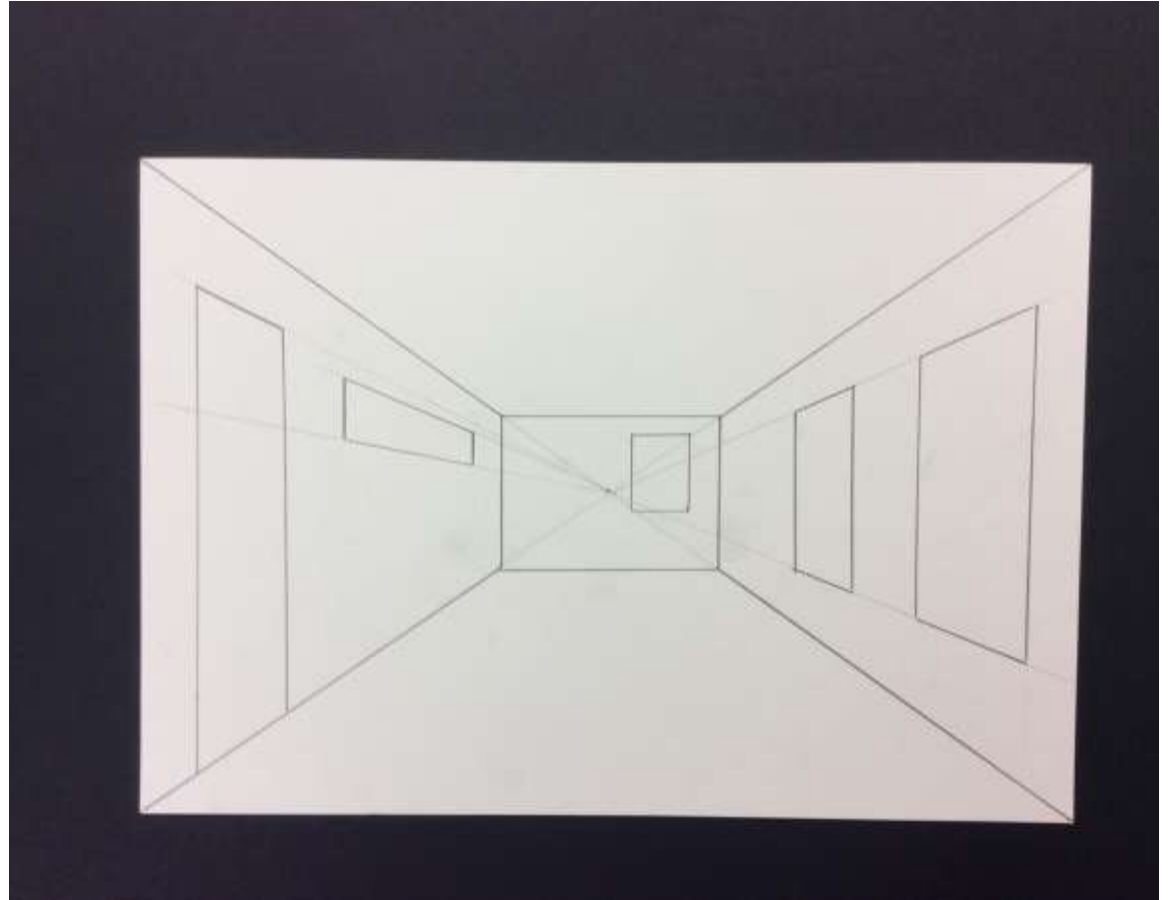


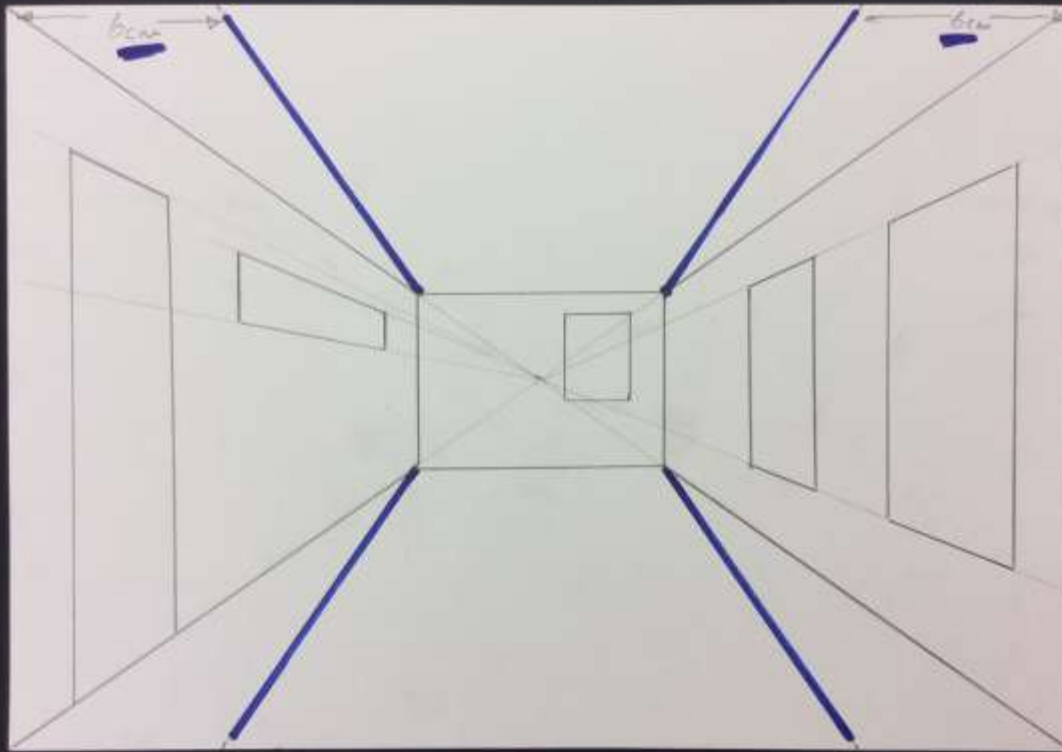


- Use a 2H pencil and ruler.
- When you are ready to darken lines, use a regular pencil.
- Create doors, windows, posters, etc. **using the very center as your vanishing point.**

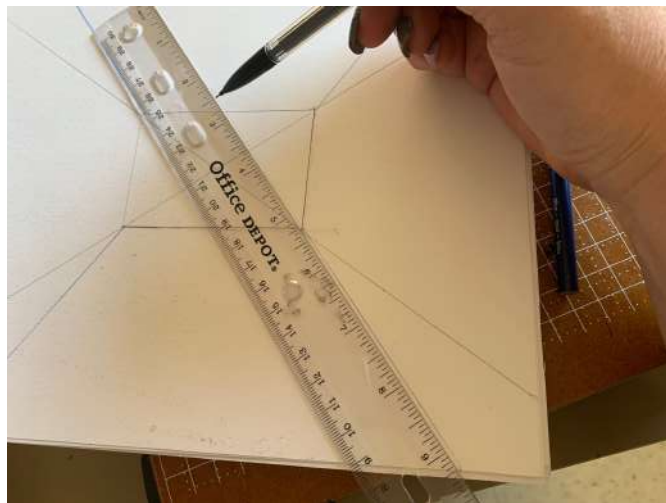
- Use a 2H pencil and ruler.
- When you are ready to darken lines, use a regular pencil.
- Create things for your back wall with NO vanishing point.

ERASE EXTRA LINES

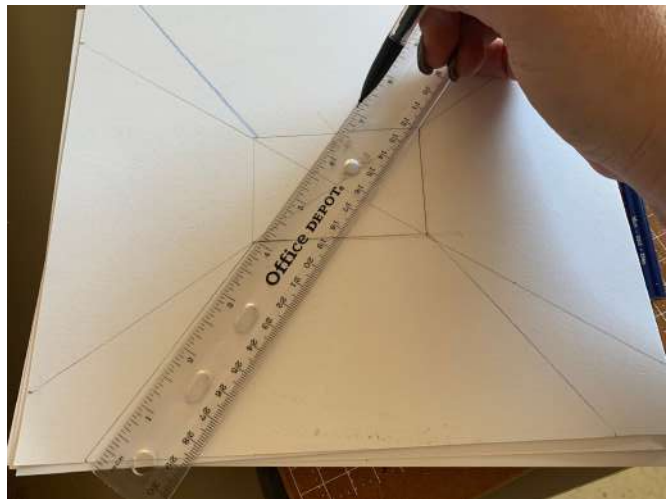




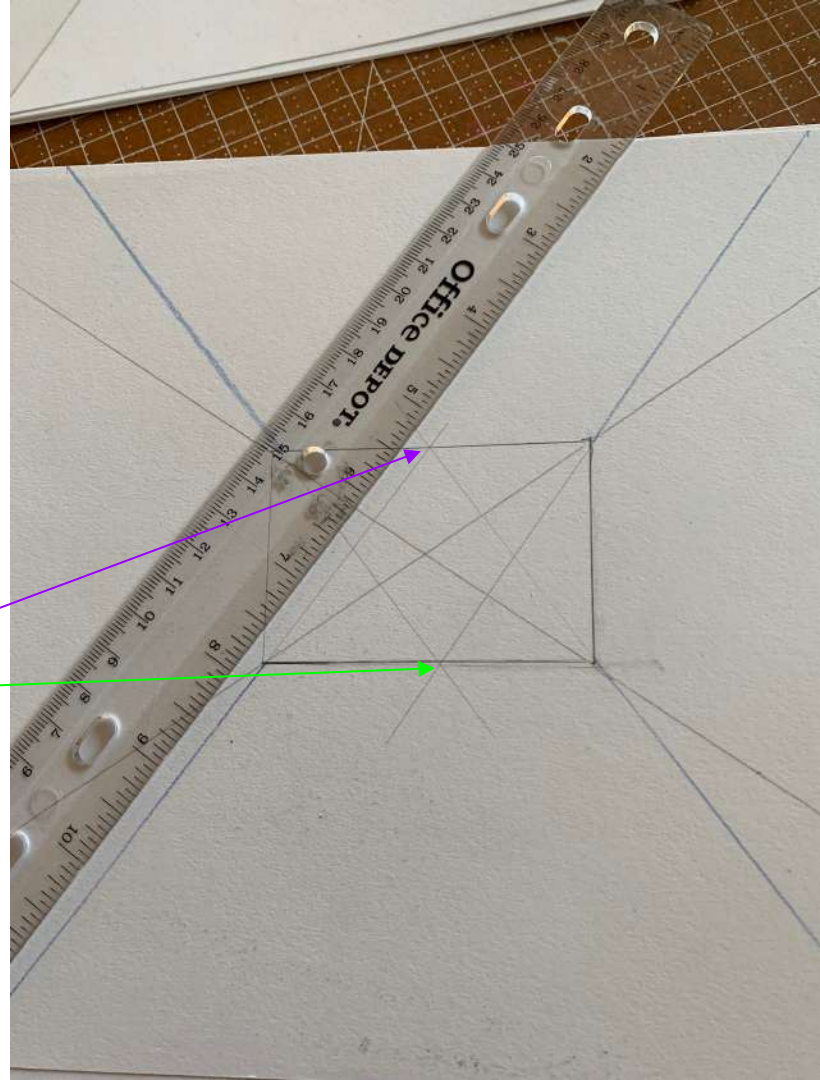
- Use a **blue colored pencil** and ruler.
- Draw a line from your top and bottom edge marks to the corner of your center rectangle.
- Do that for all four corners.



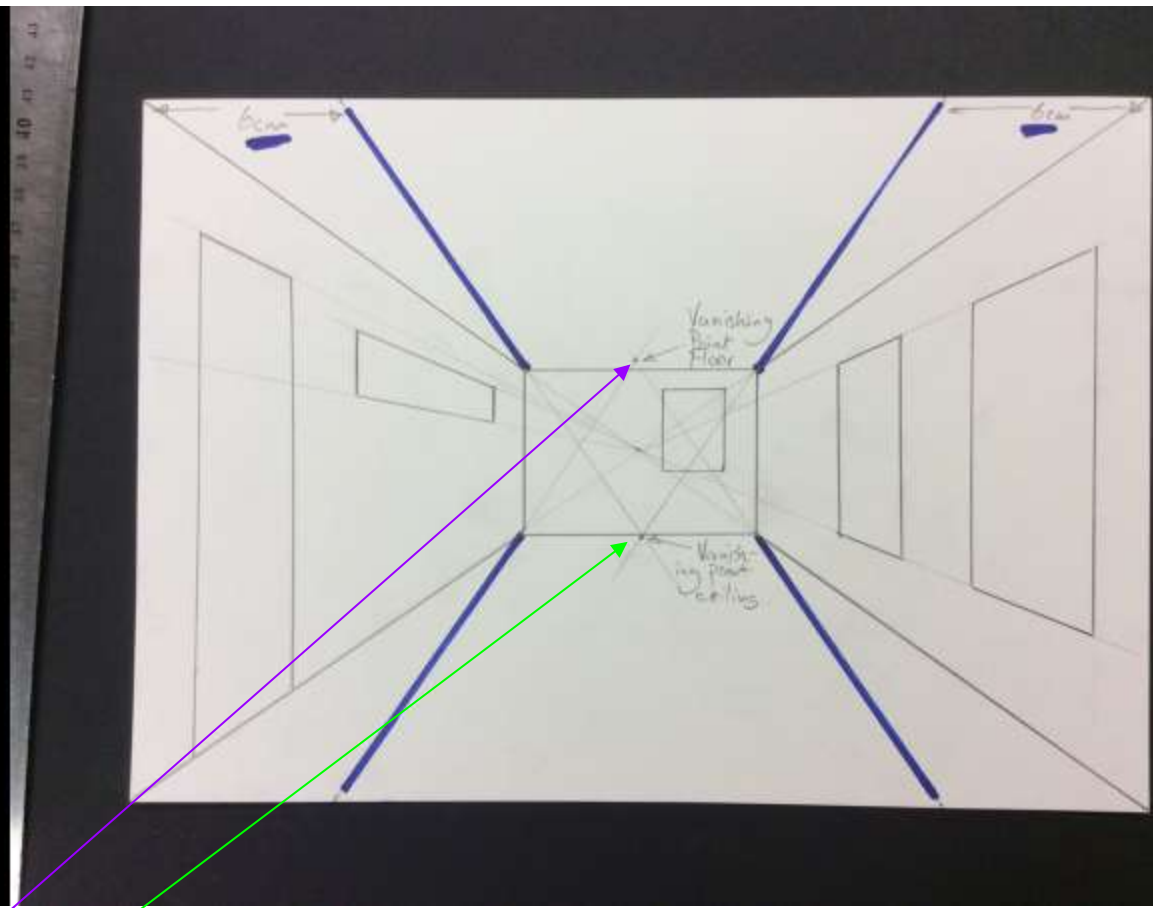
- Use a 2H pencil and ruler.
- Line up your ruler with a blue line and make a line with your 2H pencil.
- Do that for all four lines.



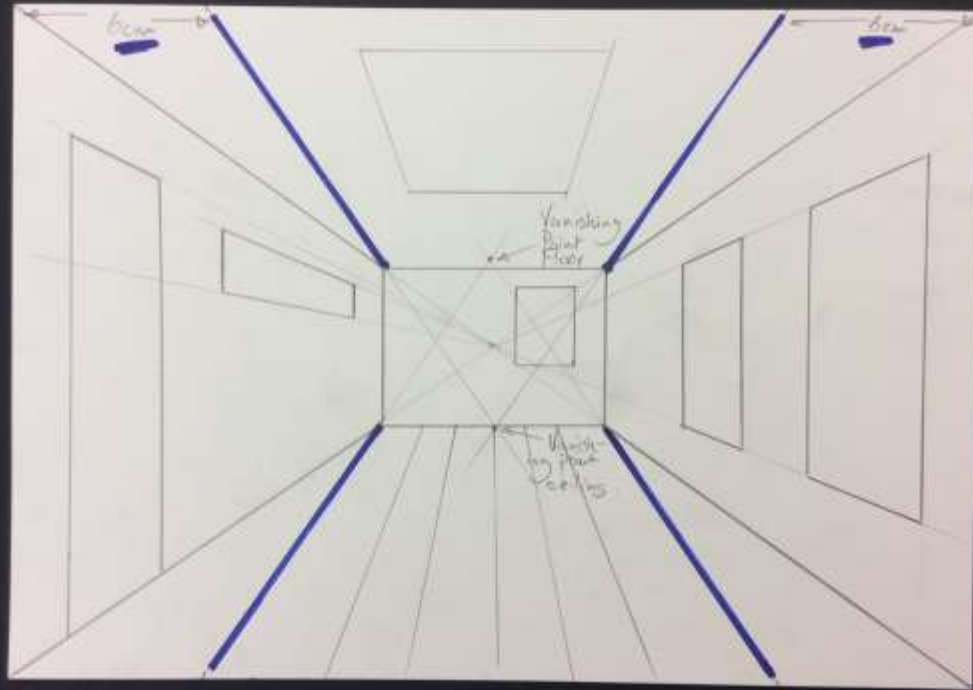
See how there  
are two  
crossed spots?







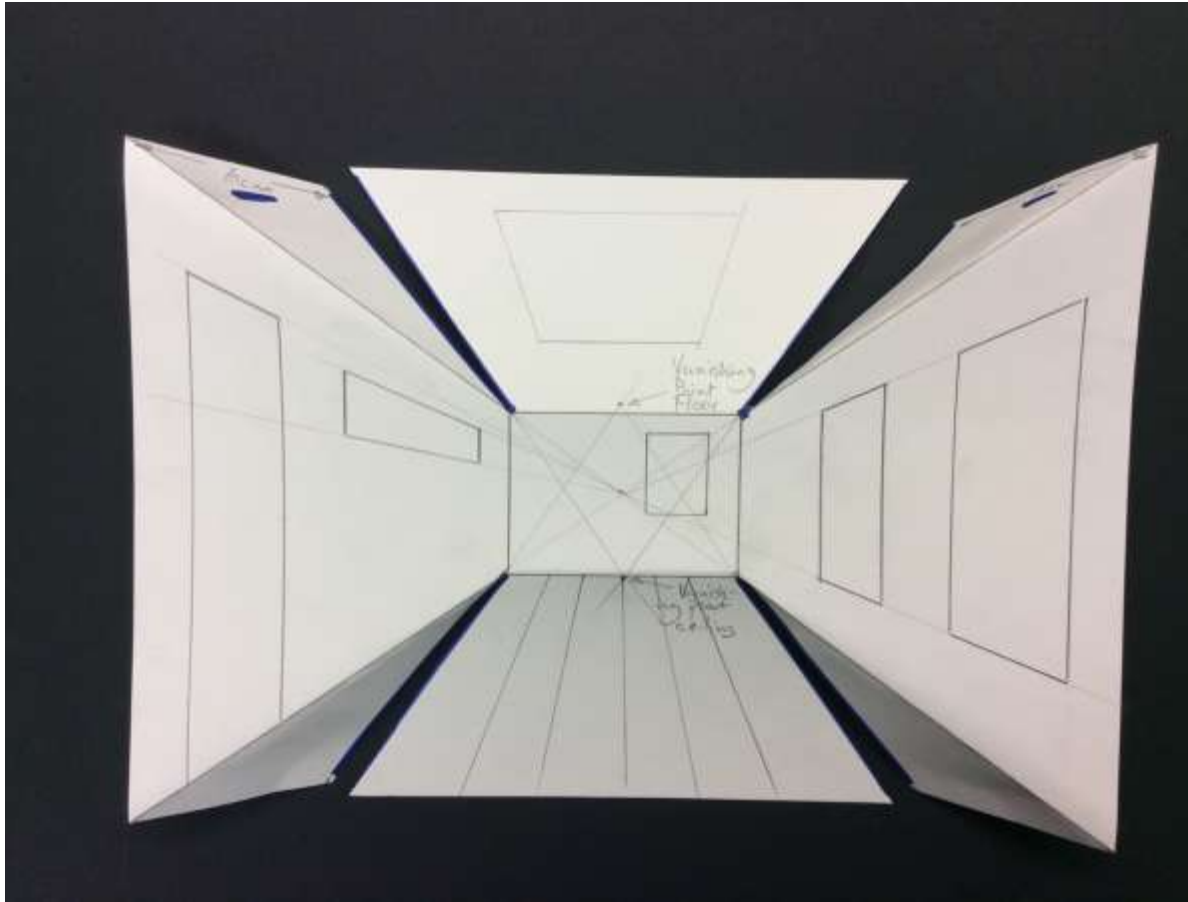
The top crossed spot is the vanishing point for floor detail.  
The bottom crossed spot is the vanishing point for ceiling detail.



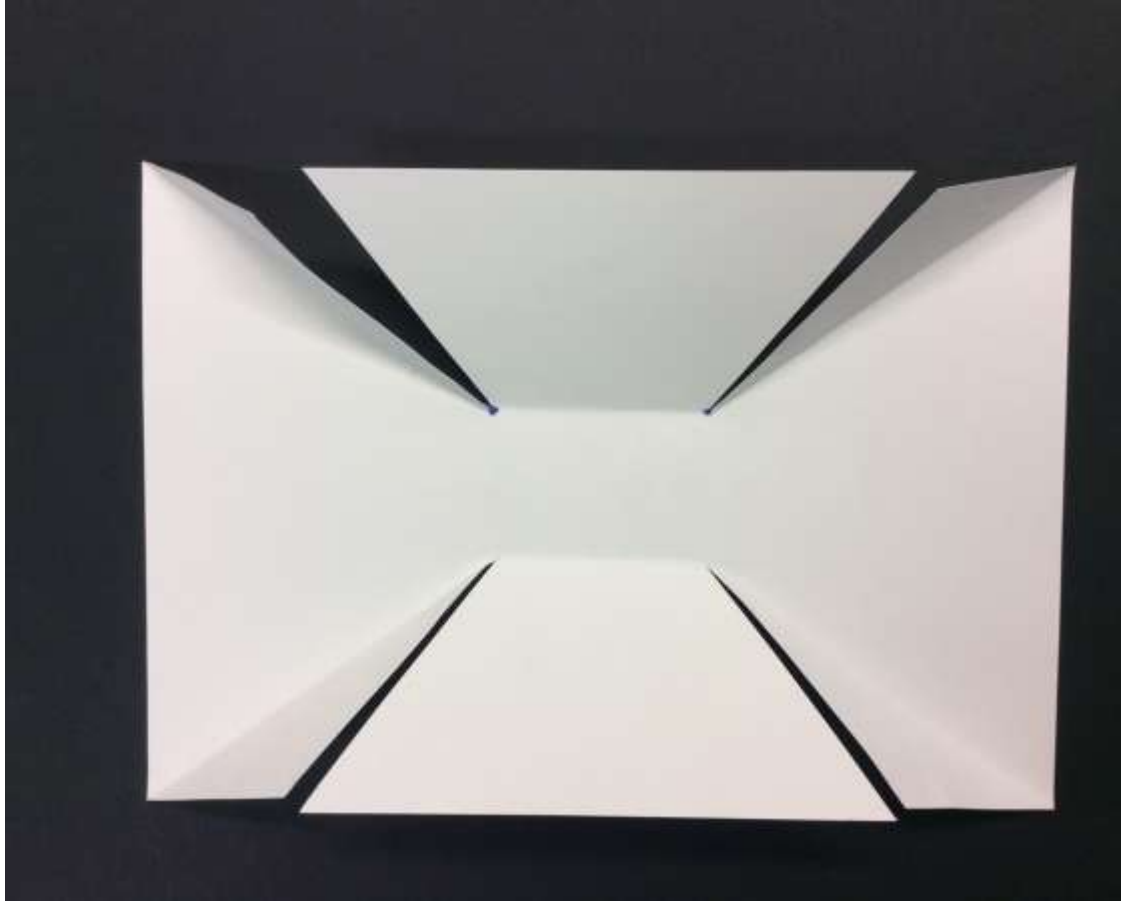
- Draw lights using the bottom vanishing point.
- Draw floors, rugs, etc. with the top vanishing point.

Erase extra lines.

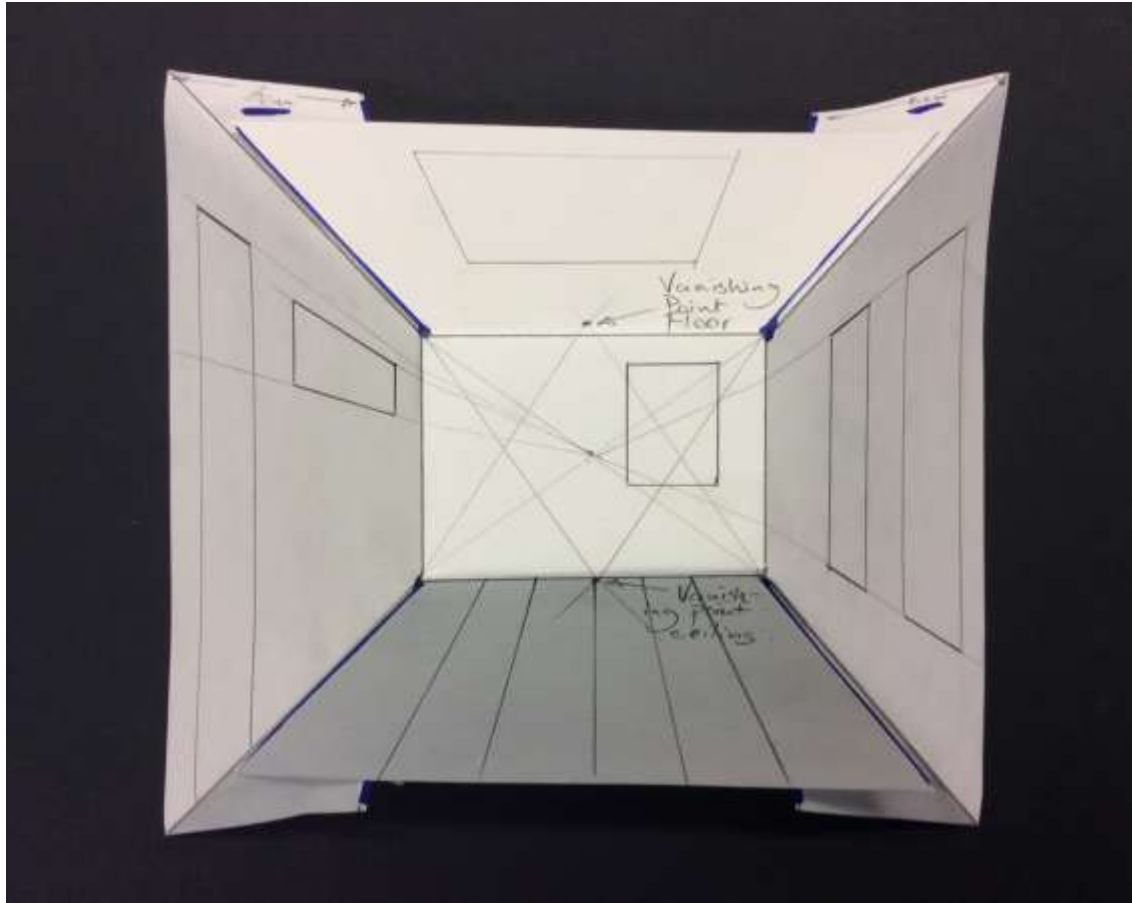
Then color it in COMPLETELY.



- Use scissors.
- Cut along all four blue lines.
- Use a ruler.
- Put your ruler along your pencil line that is the top of your walls, and fold your paper with your ruler.

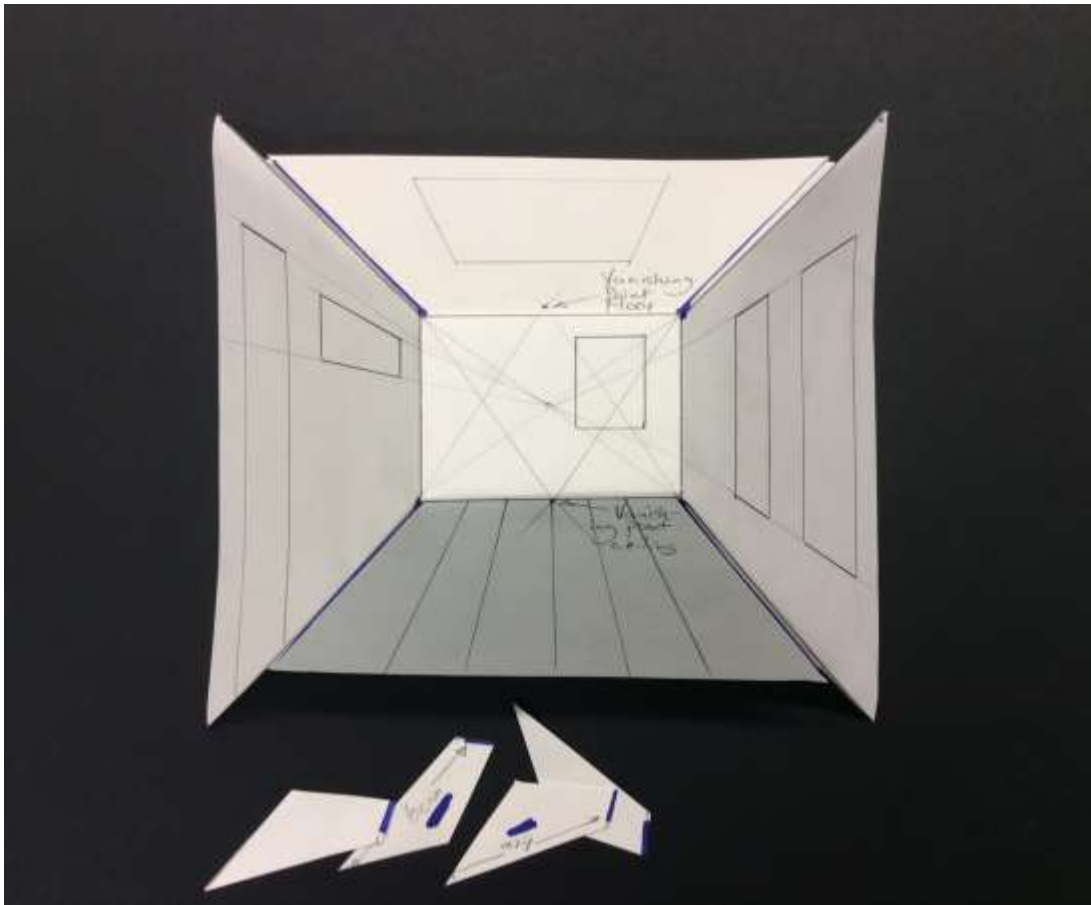


- Flip it over and fold the things you just folded toward you.
- Fold the ceiling and the floor toward you.
- Fold in the sides, too.



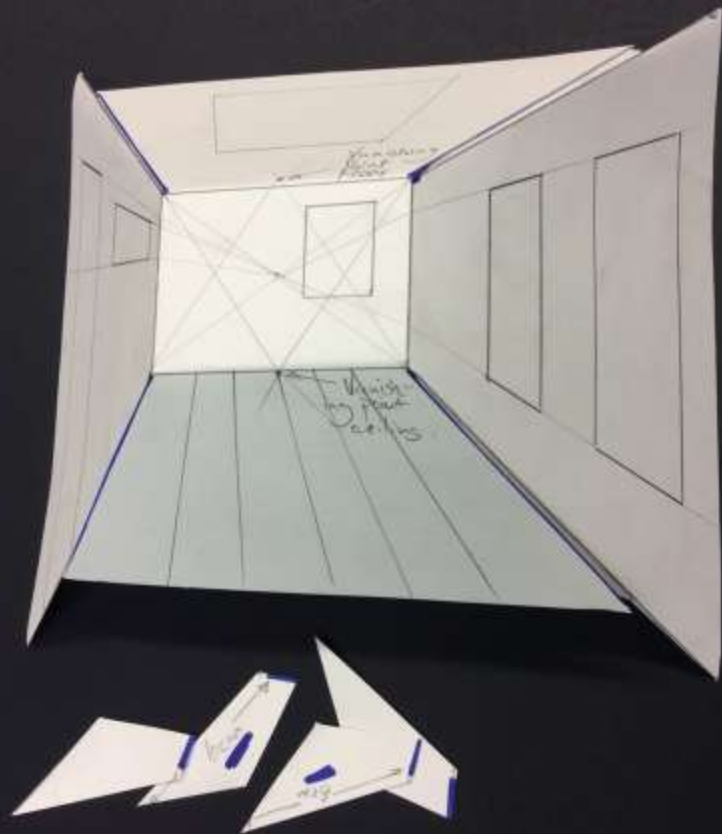
- Use glue
- Glue the flaps under your ceiling and floor.

YES, it is backwards. It's supposed to be!

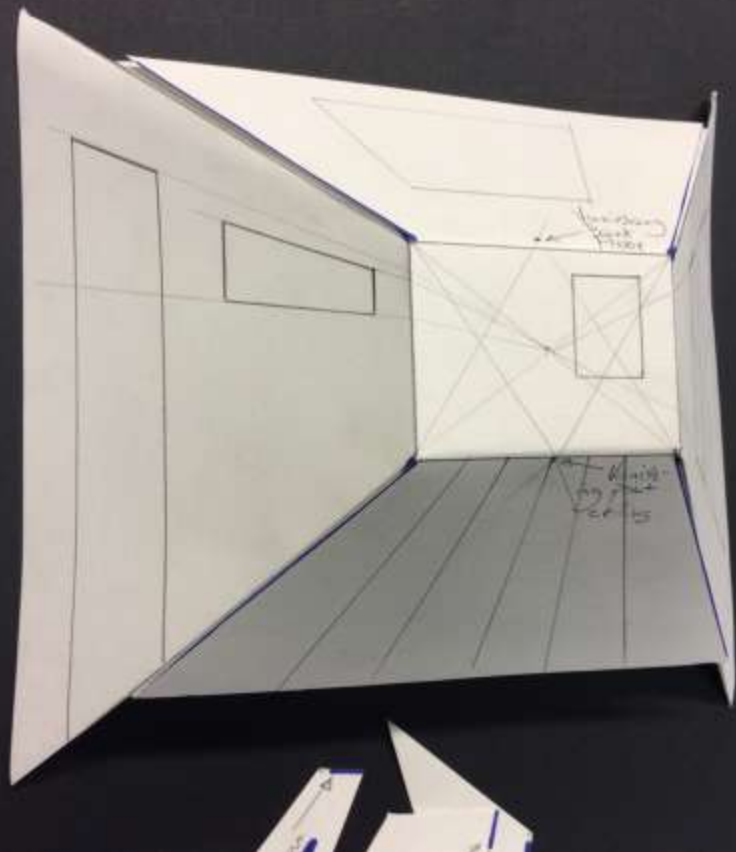


- Use scissors.
- Cut off extra pieces.

\*\*If you cut your paper correctly from slide 1, there won't be too much extra paper.









Glue (tape is fine but doesn't stick well) the edges onto colored paper.
