7. Msiilati

Civilian soldiers who are trained to fight but not part of the regular army.

8. anPilamter

The government of Great Britain, includes the king, the House of Commons, the House of Lords and the prime minister.

9. otiolasnegnnnesCtCr

The legislative assembly composed of delegates from the rebel colonies who met during and after the American Revolution.

10. ietmnMuen

Colonists who could be ready at a moment's notice to fight the British.
