



RHS Honors Diploma Requirements

Students interested in earning the RHS Honors Diploma will successfully complete the graduation requirements as outlined below:

1. Pass all state assessments: Reading, Writing, Math, Science
2. Maintain an accumulative unweighted GPA of 3.5, through 8 semesters
3. Complete all graded courses on a letter grade scale
4. Complete 27 credits
5. Earn 4 credits in advanced courses during their junior and senior years

Students should begin preparing for the Honors Diploma when they forecast for Junior courses in the spring of their Sophomore year. It is vital to take appropriate courses over a two year sequence.

Seniors need to declare their intention to graduate with an Honors Diploma to their counselor no later than **April 15** of their Senior year. Final determination of awarding an Honors Diploma will take place in June prior to graduation, based on the above criteria.
