

Summer Ossignments for Rising Third Graders





We have selected novels that will be challenging, yet will pique students' interest. Each novel ties to the curriculum for third grade.


The books are available at any branch of the Public Library of Charlotte and Mecklenburg County, your students CMS <u>OneAccess</u> account, or you may purchase the books at most bookstores or through <u>smile.amazon.com</u> (proceeds go to our school if you link your account to 'PTA North Carolina Congress Mcalpine Elementary School PTSA ').

Students: You will need to choose one novel to read from <u>each</u> assignment. **Both of these assign**ments will be part of your first literacy grades in 3rd grade. A copy of the assignment is also available on our website at <u>mcalpineelementaryschool.wearecms.com</u> and in the main office throughout the summer.

Assignment 1: On a separate sheet of paper, complete a **Plot Mountain** (see attached) on one of these books. Include your name and the title of the book.



Assignment 2: On a separate sheet of paper, complete a **Character Analysis** graphic organizer (see attached) on one of the books below. Include your name and the title of the book.



Students must complete the assignments for the novels they chose, to be turned in to their Language Arts teacher by the due date of **September 13th**. This grade will be included in their first guarter PowerSchool grade book.
