Step 3: Parents must make sure they have an updated email address in their parent portal under account information powerschool account by May 13th.

Step 4: PRHS Counselors will review requests submitted. Once reviewed an email will be sent to the student UCPS email and parent email in powerschool. Parents will need to follow information in email to approve course requests.

Choosing Classes in PowerSchool

The courses recommended by your teacher for the following will already be in PowerSchool under your course requests. If a parent would like to change the level recommended by the teacher a signed Course Level Change google form https://forms.gle/jeXmdi6wLXD6rwgc9 must be submitted.

English Math (if recommended for yearlong math will take Foundations Math 1 and Math 1) Science Social Studies Health/PE

Students will only be choosing elective classes, both 1st choice and alternate choices.

- You must select 3 first choice elective (2 if recommended for Foundations Math 1) courses.
 Electives can be from any of the following elective areas listed in PowerSchool.
 - World Language
 - Students may take level 1 and 2 in the same year if space allows
 - If you are a native speaker and understand the language choose level 2
 - If you are a native speaker and can read & write the language choose level 3
 - Fine & Performing Arts
 - For band must sign up for Band III Hon and Symphonic Band 1
 - Career Technical Education
 - PE
 - Additional (Miscellaneous, English, Math, Science and Social Studies)
 - ROTC may be taken all year. Choose ROTC Placeholder & ROTC III to take all year.
 - Yearbook requires an application <u>https://forms.gle/Q7WCGet2Ako5XBBS6</u> & is all year taking 2 elective spots
- You must select 4 **alternate elective course**s from the alternate group
 - Alternate elective courses are backup courses if you do not receive one of your first choice electives.
 - Alternates must be different courses than your first choice elective courses. Do NOT repeat courses.
 - Alternates must be courses you want to take; review the program of studies for course descriptions.
