We need to focus on Freshman being Successful at RHS

- Every freshman will become a sophomore in ONE year!!
- To become a sophomore:
 - Obtain 5 credits in your freshman year.
 - Of those 5 credits, 3 credits must be from a core class
 - English, Math, Science, Social Studies
 - If a student fails a core class, it will be \$75 to recover the credit - completed outside of the school day



Attendance is Important!

- No more than 5 parent notes for excused absences in a year. One note per day
- Hand in Doctor excuses and parent notes to the main office.
- When students improve their attendance rate, they improve their academic prospects and chances for graduating.



Signing Out

- All notes must be received by 10:00 AM
- Front office calls and confirms all notes before student may sign out in the front office on the iPad and leave through main front doors only
- Emergency Card-pick up person must be on the card or your child may not leave the building!

Automated Phone Calls: If you get a call stating that your child was absent from or tardy to one or more classes, that means your child was not present in a class. If your child is absent from school, you will get a call in the morning and afternoon. If your child is at school and you get a phone call, it could mean that your child is skipping class. Please contact the school if this occurs so we can locate your child and ensure they are safe.

Preassignments: Due to a substitute teacher shortage, if a teacher is absent and does not have a substitute, your child will look at the teacher's door and go to the assigned class listed for that class period. They will fill out a QR code when they arrive to that teacher's class and begin working on the assignment left by their teacher. If a student is preassigned, you will **NOT** get an automated call saying they are absent from class. The actual teacher enters the absence not the preassigned teacher. If you get a call, they are skipping class and their teacher is present.

Lunch Detention

Any student that behaves in a way that does not follow the code of conduct or rules at Riverside High may receive lunch detention. It will be held in a special area of the commons during the student's lunch period.

Dress Code

- No apparel that contains images of weapons, drug emblems, obscenities, tobacco or alcoholic beverage references.
- Do not show undergarments
- Shirts or blouses must cover the entire torso at all times, even in movement - no tube tops, spaghetti straps
- Shorts & pants must not show buttocks or private areas
- No hoods covering your head and no hats worn in building



Lunch in the Commons



Students will report to lunch based on their 4th period teacher. If a student has first lunch, they report after Period 3. If a student has second lunch, they report after Period 4.

Students have 3 choices for lunch – main line and in the concession they have fast and fresh or pizza options.

Students may pack their lunches, but no fast-food deliveries by guardians or delivery services can be sent or brought to the school. Students may only go to the vending machine or snack machine before school or after school.

We have water filling stations throughout the building so students can fill a water bottle with filtered water. One is in the lunchroom by the main lunch line, the upstairs station is near B23 by girls' red restroom, and the downstairs station is near A53 by yellow girls' restroom
