The coursework must include the following:

1. Four years of Language Arts (9-12)
2. Three years of Mathematics
3. Two years of U.S. History
4. One year of World History
5. Three years of Science
6. Two consecutive years of World Language
7. One year of Health & Physical Education for each year enrolled
8. One year of Visual and Performing Arts
9. One year of Career Education, Family Consumer Science, or Vo. Tech
10. Half year of Financial Literacy

### RHS RESPONSE TO COVID-19

Our priority during the COVID-19 pandemic is the safety of students and staff. The 2019 - 2020 school year transitioned to a mix of synchronous and asynchronous virtual learning on March 13, 2020 through the end of the school year. While final exams were not held, the final grades displayed on transcripts accurately represent grades earned by students through the full four marking periods of work. The Robbinsville Public Schools remained committed to the strength and rigor of our curriculum. The 2020 - 2021 school year began in an all virtual, synchronous learning model. Beginning in mid-October 2020, students had the option to select between a hybrid or full virtual model. By spring 2021, our students were back in school full day. Our grading scale remained on the same scale, the final grades displayed on transcripts accurately represent grades earned by students through the full four marking period of work. The 2021 - 2022 and 2022 - 2023 school years are in person full day.
