How to Apply

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Individual must be a currently enrolled high school senior eligible to attend a 2 to 4 year college, university, or vocational/technical school with a complete course of study.
- 2. Individual must be a legal U.S. resident.
- 3. Individual must be less than 21 years of age.
- 4. Individual must reside in a county within the geographical boundaries of Ronald McDonald House Charities of Eastern Iowa & Western Illinois chapter:

IOWA: Benton, Bremer, Black Hawk, Buchanan, Cedar, Chickasaw, Clayton, Clinton, Delaware, Des Moines, Dubuque, Fayette, Henry, Iowa, Jackson, Jefferson, Johnson, Jones, Lee, Linn, Louisa, Muscatine, Scott and Washington.

- ** Although it is not required, preference will be given to applicants who have either:
- A) Had a serious childhood illness or injury.
- B) Had a sibling who had a serious childhood illness or injury which impacted the family.
- C)Volunteered for any Ronald McDonald House Charities Chapter

Required Documents

The following documents must be uploaded during the online application process:

- 1. A certified high school transcript that contains the student's class rank and test scores.
- 2. Applicants must submit a personal statement that provides information and their community involvement, career goals, and desire to contribute to their community (500 words maximum).
- 3. A one-page letter of recommendation from one of applicant's teachers or school official.
