Dear Family Members,

In our continuing efforts to support the well-being of all our students, we are administering a universal screener of social, emotional & behavioral health. Our district is using the *Behavior Intervention Monitoring Assessment System-2 (BIMAS-2)* research-based screening tool. The focus of this universal screener is to increase support systems for all RHS students promoting their educational success. This universal screener has a variety of sections such as "student Self-Report". Our RHS 8th -12th grade students will participate in the student self-reports. Your student will be invited to participate in a brief survey that consists of 34 questions and takes 3-5 minutes to administer. 8th grade students at Rawlinson Road Middle School will complete the survey on their laptop on Tuesday, October 1st, 2024.

Each 8th – 12th grade student will be asked to complete the BIMAS-2 questionnaire that asks about their actions and emotions during a one-week time span. Examples of some of the questions include:

- During the past week I shared my thoughts with others.
- During the past week I had trouble paying attention.
- During the past week I followed directions.
- During the past week I was sad or withdrawn.

For each question, the student will answer "never," "rarely," "sometimes," "often," or "very often."

Once completed, the BIMAS-2 results will be reviewed by the support staff at the school and designated District Office Staff. The aim of this screener is to help students become successful in receiving any additional support they may require, promoting their well-being and overall education.
