(HIGH SCHOOL GPA X 12.5) + (ACT X 1.38889) = SCORE**

Tier 1	88+	\$2,500/year - 4 years
Tier 2	82-87	\$2,000/year - 4 years
Tier 3	76-81	\$1,800/year - 4 years
Tier 4	70-75	\$1,500/year - 4 years

Must maintain full-time enrollment, be a U.S. citizen, Oklahoma resident, and first-time incoming freshman

Additional scholarships are available through the RSU Foundation office, a separate application is required to qualify for RSU Foundation Scholarships

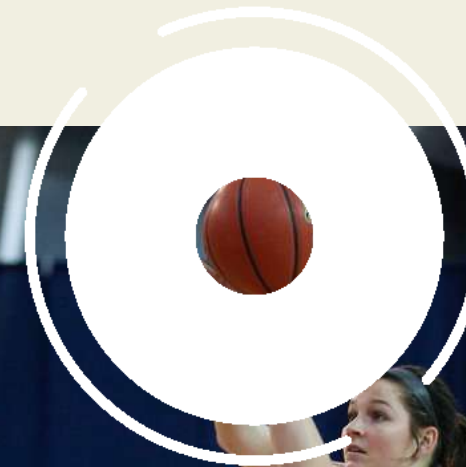
