Classroom Expansion

Conversations surrounding the Classroom Expansion across the district have continued. The Design Phase of the project will continue through March and April 2023. Plans continue to move forward.



New Property

The Festus R-VI School District has purchased the property at the corner of Mid-Meadow Lane (1601 Mid-Meadow). Plans are currently being developed to turn this property into a school based health clinic (SBHC). If you recall, the SBHC was originally part of the Wellness/Gym construction project as an add-alternative in the original build. With the opportunity to purchase the 1601 Mid-Meadow Lane property, it allowed us to save money on renovations rather than new construction. I am excited about this opportunity for our students and families. As you know, the district frequently contracts to have multiple providers on campus throughout the school year (eye thrive van, dental van, wellness vans, physicals etc). These providers frequently are traveling vans that can only stay in one location for a designated number of days. Having the SBHC will allow us to have multiple providers on campus throughout the entire school year. It will also house several other services such as: our partnership project with outside counseling and psychiatric services, mental/behavioral health, and psychological examiners to name a few.

For many years Festus Middle School has been used as the polling place for local elections each year. The utilization of Festus Middle School has caused the district to have to cancel school or declare the use of an AMI day to ensure students were not on campus during the election. This year, in collaboration with the County Clerk Jeannie Goff, it was determined that the election polling place would be relocated to the Performing Arts Center for elections. School will be in session as regularly scheduled on April 4th, 2023.



Safety & Security

As mentioned in an earlier newsletter, safety and security surrounding our district is of utmost importance to me. The SROs and I continue to meet on a regular basis to discuss continued security enhancements at each attendance center. Our SROs along with local first responders recently participated in Tier One Training to continue to enhance their skills in the event of emergency situations. Although they have been through multiple training sessions and are well trained, it is my philosophy that there is always room for improvement and growth.



State Assessment

Per DESE (Department of Elementary and Secondary Education) ALL school districts will be required to administer the 2022-2023 state assessments (MAP/EOC). Despite the many opinions about the relevance of administering state assessments it is our state accountability measure and a regulation we must abide by. The state testing window that has been established is April 3rd - May 26th, 2023. Currently each school attendance center is determining their specific testing window. As always, 3rd-8th grade will administer the ELA and Math Grade Level Assessment while 5th and 8th Grade will administer the Science assessment.


Required End-of-Course (EOC) assessments remain for: *Algebra I, English II, Government, and Biology*. R-VI will also administer the optional assessments for English I, American History, and Physical Science.




Soccer Sportsmanship Award
