- 5. All other ACHS rules apply as well.

Consequences:

- 1. 1st offense will result in me discussing it with you immediately.
- 2. 2nd offense: keep you after class and discuss any problem.
- 3. 3rd offense: referral and call home

I do not tolerate poor behavior in class. Parents pay their hard earned money for their children to receive a good education. Students who get in the way of that will be dealt with quickly and efficiently.
