GREEN TEAM

The purpose of the Green Team is to maintain the paper recycling efforts at the Ryan School by collecting and placing paper in the Paper Retriever during after school hours. Our goal is to continue

to increase the recycling awareness and participation at the Ryan, which not only helps our environment, but also reduces the bulk waste our school produces.

Paper Recycling is also an easy revenue source for the Ryan PAC, which earns \$\$\$ for every ton of paper recycled. This money is then spent on things that benefit the Ryan School students.

The after school activity is open to interested 5th or 6th grade students. The Green Team will need a total of 8 committed members each session. First come first serve. The first session will be a total of 10 weeks beginning on THURSDAYS AFTER SCHOOL from 2:30-3:15 pm, starting 10/11/18 through 12/20/18 (excluding the week of 11/22/18). Interested??

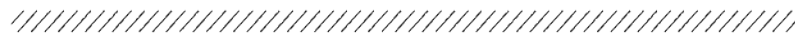
