- III. Parent concerns:
  - a. Sudden drop of Advanced Spanish II; this brings concerns of students being prepared for AP or IB level work when the time comes; parent did not know of the course being dropped until she attended the IGP meeting with her freshmen daughter.
    - i. District Office personnel informed her that the content in Spanish II is the same content that would be taught in Adv. Spanish II; however, parent understands that the ADV. portion of the course is designed to ready the students for AP/IB level work whereas Spanish II content will not necessarily push students.
    - ii. Committee wishes to send a letter to Central Office expressing concerns over dropped course and expectations for those high achieving students who would like to take AP/IB course load
  - b. Concerns with differences between middle schools and their suggestions for advanced studies students was brought to group's attention
    - i. Mr. Herrington, guidance department, suggested we talk further with middle schools and what the high schools offer/expect
