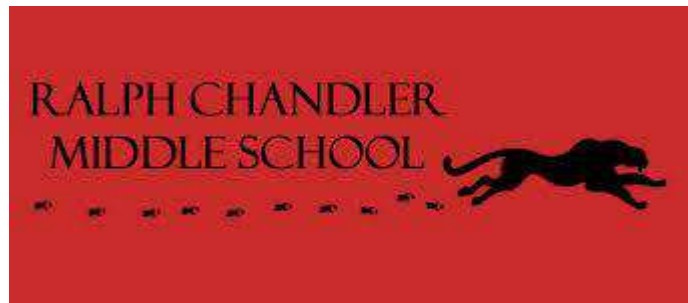

Why?

In South Carolina, every public school is required to have a SIC. Its purpose is to serve as an advisory committee to the school's principal. The purpose of the SIC includes:

- Participation in the preparation and revision, if necessary, of the school's five-year strategic plan and evaluation of the outcomes.
- Preparation of an annual school report by April 30th to provide information on the school's progress in meeting the school's and district's goals and objectives.

Who?

- Parents/guardians elect six parents/guardians for two year terms.
- Faculty elects three teachers for two-year terms
- The principal invites members representing the community for two year terms.

When?

The SIC meets monthly for approximately 1 ½ hours. There may be some additional committee work. Individual work beyond that varies based on the initiatives identified by the SIC.

Elections

Using the nomination attached, you may nominate another parent/guardian or nominate yourself by completing and returning the form to the Front Office.
