Nominations for Parent Representatives Fall 2020

The TEK School Improvement Council (SIC) is an advisory council to the principal that is focused on school improvement issues. It is made up of representatives of parents, teachers, and community members. The principal serves as an ex-officio member. The SIC meets at least monthly during the school year to focus on school improvement.

Parent representatives are elected to a term of one year. TEK parent representatives are nominated and elected by their fellow TEK parents. Any parent/guardian of at least one child enrolled in TEK is eligible to place his/her own name or the name of another parent in nomination. A representative of the SIC will contact all individuals whose names are submitted into nomination prior to the election to confirm acceptance of the nomination. Nominees will be invited to share a brief statement about themselves and why they want to serve on the SIC. All statements received will be included on the ballot so that voters will have a chance to get to know each of the candidates.
