School Priority: Engaging Instruction and Assessment

- Sevier is at its largest enrollment in history -- 742 students

STEAM

- STEAM principles and practices are embedded in instruction as teachers use hands on learning and design thinking in multiple courses.
- Cross-curricular units (2 or more courses) are being refined or developed for implementation through the semester
- Multiple opportunities are planned for Enrichment sessions to further integrate project-based learning practices.

ENRICHMENT

Our structured enrichment program meets for 42 minutes on 18 Fridays at the start of the school day. Each student attends 6 seminars of 3 Friday mornings each. All professional staff members are directly involved in the delivery of targeted academic support, academic advancement, or special interest opportunities.
