Math:

Buckland Elementary School Improvement Goal 2.1: The percentage of 3rd grade students scoring proficient or higher in third grade math will increase from 59.7% to 65.5% as measured by the North Carolina End of Grade Math assessment administered on June 1, 2017.

Buckland Elementary School Improvement Goal 2.2: The percentage of 4th grade students scoring proficient or higher in 4th grade math will increased from 80.56% to 82% as measured by the NC EOG- math and administered on 6-1-17.

Buckland Elementary School Improvement Goal2.3: The percentage of 5th grade students scoring proficient or higher in 5th grade math will increased from 57.50% to 65.5% as measured by NC EOG math and administered on June 1, 2017.

Reading:
