ello Sabre families! We have had an outstanding opening week at South Mecklenburg High School. With time spent to be sure important information was shared and made clear, students have begun the learning activities teachers have planned for their classes, and indications of investment and enthusiasm are all around us. Grade level meetings shared with students some exciting opportunities, and the expectations we have for them in order to have the best year ever!

As a school, we have three goals in on which our activities this year, aligned with those outlined by our learning community, are based: promoting students' academic growth, ensuring a safe and supportive school environment, and community engagement. As a faculty, and working with parent leaders, we have already begun plans to realize our goals.

Students have been very cooperative and involved in school in these first days; new teachers have commented on how positive and respectful students have been and how welcome they feel at our school. As I shared with them, South Meck will be the school they help us to be, and these early signs indicate a very bright prospect for us all.

You will have an opportunity to meet your students' teachers at one or both of the meet the teacher nights scheduled for the start of the school year. After seeing last year that our growing population (bigger still this year) created challenges for parking and navigating our campus, we decided to divide the event this year between two dates. Tuesday evening after the long weekend, 9/2 at 5:30 PM, we will hold the Meet the Teacher event for 9th grade families. The following Tuesday, 9/9, again at 5:30 PM, we will be welcoming families of 10th – 12th graders. Details for both evenings will be provided via phone call. Please note that due to limited parking we will also provide remote parking at Quail Hollow Presbyterian Church beginning at 5pm with shuttle service on each of these dates, so please take advantage of this opportunity.

All this week students were able to submit schedule change forms for consideration, based on the criteria provided for that process. While this Friday, 8/29 was the last date for submission of request forms, the actual process of considering change options will continue until all requests have been evaluated. Please be patient as counselors work through each, and make whatever changes are possible. We anticipate the possibility of additional staff due to increases over projected enrollment, and these may open up opportunities for additional flexibility. We will communicate such opportunities in a timely fashion if and when they are available.

We look forward to 2014-2015 being the best school year ever for South Mecklenburg. While official data from last school year is not yet available, every indication is that we made substantial gains in key outcomes. Goals we are setting for our students and ourselves this year promise to be challenging and, when (not if!) achieved they will be beneficial to our students in many ways. Their success, and our success as a school, is greatly enhanced by your roles as partners with us and with your students. Please seek every opportunity to be engaged in support of your students and of our school community. Together we can achieve more!

## Regarding Your Child's Medicine And Health Concerns


