As a school, we are committed to your child's academic success. We also greatly value their social and emotional wellbeing. This year, we will be providing the Social, Academic, and Emotional Behavioral Risk Screener (SAEBRS). This is not a diagnostic tool and will not diagnose your child with anything! The goal of providing this screener is to give accurate data to our teachers and counselor to best serve our students.

With the data collected, we will see which students are having the greatest difficulties socially, academically, or emotionally and provide services to meet those needs. As a school we provide reading screeners throughout the year to see which students need additional reading support, this screener is done in the same fashion.

There are 19 questions asked on the screener. Students in grades 2-5 self-answer via their ipad or computer, and grades K-1 will have their classroom teachers answer on behalf of the student.
