Teaching Pay Scale Chart Information and Description of Pay Levels

*Teachers earning less than \$38,000 will receive the difference between their pay on the **Teaching Pay Scale Chart** and \$38,000 with the passage of an annual state appropriation (grant). This difference will be paid in two installments of 50% each minus all applicable taxes and retirement. One payment will occur in the December 2023 payroll and the other in May 2024 payroll.

Teachers that are currently in positions in which they are not fully certified are grandfathered into their current step and level advancement for two years; 2023-24 and 2024-25 **if they only lack a certification test. Example: A teacher is MS step 6 for 2022-23, will move to MS step 7 for 23-24 and MS step 8 for 2024-25. During the two-year period, the teacher must earn full certification in their assigned area to proceed on the salary schedule to, for example, MS step 9. Otherwise, the teacher will move to one of the uncertified levels. The teacher must have an approved plan and timeline with the district to become fully certified.

***Teachers that are currently in positions in which they are not fully certified are grandfathered into their current step and level advancement for four years; 2023-24, 2024-25, 2025-26, and 2026-27 **if they lack college hours AND a certification test**. Example: A teacher is MS step 6 for 2022-23, will move to MS step 7 for 23-24 and MS step 8 for 2024-25, MS step 9 for 2025-26, and MS step 10 for 2026-27. During the four-year period, the teacher must earn full certification in their assigned area to proceed on the salary schedule. Otherwise, the teacher will move to one of the uncertified levels. The teacher must have an approved plan and timeline with the district to become fully certified.

Description of Teacher Certification levels:

Sub Cert

Current substitute certification with DESE. The teacher must maintain full substitute certification and have a plan on file with the district toward full certification in a teaching area. The teacher has less than a BS degree.

BS Sub Cert TAC

Current substitute certification with DESE. The teacher must maintain full substitute certification and have a plan on file with the district toward full certification in a teaching area. The teacher has at least a BS degree.

OR

Current temporary authorization certificate (TAC) with DESE. The teacher must maintain full TAC with DESE and have a plan on file with the district and an approved plan with DESE toward full certification in a teaching area. The teacher has a BS degree.

BS Cert

Current DESE-approved teaching certification with the state of Missouri. The teacher must maintain full certification during the school year. The teacher has a BS degree.

BS NBTC, RS, DCert

Current DESE-approved teaching certification with the state of Missouri. The teacher must maintain full certification during the school year. The teacher has a BS degree and one of the following 1) reading specialist certification from a DESE-approved program of study, 2) current National Board Certification, 3) Teaching in two areas - Dual certified: The teacher holds an additional current teaching certification and is teaching two or more areas - ex. Math, Science, Social Studies, Special Education, PE, or English

MS Cert

Current DESE-approved teaching certification with the state of Missouri. The teacher must maintain full certification during the school year. The teacher has an MS degree.

MS+30 Cert

Current DESE-approved teaching certification with the state of Missouri. The teacher must maintain full certification during the school year. The teacher has an MS degree and has earned an additional 30 approved by the district graduate hours 500 level or above, which are related to their teaching area or continued professional development and from an accredited college or university.

MS NBTC, RS, DCert, Dual C, AP

Current DESE-approved teaching certification with the state of Missouri. The teacher must maintain full certification during the school year. The teacher has an MS degree and one of the following 1) reading specialist certification from a DESE-approved program of study, 2) current National Board Certification, 3) Teaching in two areas - Dual certified: The teacher holds an additional current teaching certification and is teaching two or more areas - ex. Math, Science, Social Studies, Special Education, PE, or English; 4) The teacher teaches one or more AP or Dual Credit courses

SPEC Cert

Current DESE-approved teaching certification with the state of Missouri. The teacher must maintain full certification during the school year. The teacher has a Specialist degree in one of the following areas: 1) Administration, 2) Curriculum and Instruction, 3) Reading, 4) Education Technology, 5) Special Education, or 6) Another recognized education field of study.

DOC Cert

Current DESE-approved teaching certification with the state of Missouri. The teacher must maintain full certification during the school year. The teacher has a doctoral degree in one of the following areas: 1) Administration, 2) Curriculum and Instruction, 3) Reading, 4) Education Technology, 5) Special Education, 6) Education Leadership and Policy Analysis, and 7) Another recognized education field of study.
