Steps to a Valid Pacing Guide: Design your Pacing Guide according to your Blueprint

- 1. Obtain your school calendar
- 2. Subtract non-instructional days from total school days.
- 3. Use this number of "actual days of instruction in the following formula"

Formula: Actual Instructional days X Cognitive + Performance Weights

Steps to a Creating a Valid Benchmark Test: Design your Benchmark Test according to your Blueprint

- 1. Obtain your school calendar
- 2. Subtract non-instructional days from total school days.
- 3. Use this number of "actual days of instruction in the following formula"

Formula: Cognitive + Performance Weights X <u>Number of Questions on Assessment</u>
