

2019 TIMELINE FOR GRANT APPLICATION AND SUBSTANTIALLY APPROVABLE STATUS (SAS) PROCESS FOR FEDERAL FORMULA GRANTS (REAP; SPECIAL EDUCATION; TITLE I, A & C; TITLE II, A; TITLE III, AND CARL PERKINS)

DATE	PROCESS
May 1	<p>Preliminary allocations released and applications are ready in iGrants.</p> <p>Note: While May 1 is OSPI's target date for launching iGrants, preliminary allocations and applications will be posted as soon as available. LEAs (local education agencies) will be notified through iGrants as allocations and applications are made available.</p>
July 1	<p>Last day for LEAs to submit a SAS request for a July 1 spending start date.</p> <p>Special Education Form Package 267 applications received by July 1 receive a spending start date of July 1. Applications received after July 1 are subject to a spending start date of the date received at OSPI unless otherwise requested in the Notes Tab of Form Package 267.</p>
Summer	<p>Target turnaround time for review of submitted applications either substantially approvable or final approval status is no more than 30 calendar days, unless otherwise communicated from an individual program office. Our intent is to have all applications approved within 30 days. Applications that need revision could extend the timeline for final approval. Final allocations posted as soon as available and completed.</p>
August	<p>LEAs who have not submitted or started process are identified and individual OPSI program offices will work with district staff, as applicable.</p>
September	<p>LEAs that have fully completed and approved grant applications may begin submitting reimbursement requests.</p>
October 12	<p>LEAs deadline to notify OSPI of <u>intent to participate</u> in all programs, unless otherwise communicated from an individual program office.</p>
