

You should receive a confirmation message back confirming you have opted in. Your cell phone number must be registered with the school as a primary contact number for you to opt into and receive district text alerts. STUDENTTRANSPORTATION

Bus Route Numbers & Late Buses: Our buses are identified by route numbers (example: Route 1, Route 2) posted next to the bus doors and in the second window on the passenger side.

Each school has its own late buses. CES late buses leave school at 3:00 PM and Maple Hill late buses leave at 3:15 PM. Late buses run on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday only.

Requesting Someone Else Pick Up Student:

Maple Hill: Please send a message to the Maple Hill Attendance Email (MHHS-Attendance@schodack.k12.ny.us) letting the school know who will be picking up your student. Please include your student's name and the dates.

Castleton ES: Please send a message to the Castleton ES Attendance Email (CES-Attendance@schodack.k12.ny.us) stating who will be picking up your student or send in a Dismissal Note located under Parent Fliers on the CES page of the district website. Please also use the PikMyKid app by 1 p.m. on the day of to delegate the person picking up your student.

Early Release Requests: If your student needs to be excused early from for a medical appointment or any other reason, please do the following.

Maple Hill: Please send a message to the Maple Hill Attendance Email (MHHS-Attendance@schodack.k12.ny.us). Please include your student's name, the dates they will need to leave early and the reason why.

Castleton ES: Please send a message to the Castleton ES Attendance Email (CES-Attendance@schodack.k12.ny.us) or send in a Dismissal Note located under Parent Fliers on the CES page of the district website. Include your student's name, the dates and the reason why. Students must be signed out at the Main Office for early dismissal.

STUDENT DROP OFF

Dropping Off Students: If you drop off your child in the morning, please use the designated parent drop off zones and do not leave your car unattended. For the safety of our students, please drive slowly and take extra care to look for students. Give yourself enough time to drop off your student safely. Please do not use designated bus loops to drop off students.

Dropping Off Students After School Starts:

If your student is going to be late for school, please provide a written excuse for the student's tardiness. Students arriving late to school should report directly to the school's main office. For more information, please see the student handbooks which are available online at www.schodack.k12.ny.us.

Please No Parking in Bus Loop: Please do not park your vehicle in the bus loop of the school buildings. For the safety of our students, faculty and staff, it is imperative that bus loops be kept clear for emergency vehicles.

Please Drive Carefully: For the safety of our students, we ask all visitors to please take extra caution when driving on school grounds. Drop off location and parking lots can get quite busy so please adhere to the 15 MPH speed limit and watch carefully for students. It is illegal to pass a stopped school bus when its signal lights are flashing.

Dignity for All Students Act

All students have a right to attend school in a safe, welcoming and caring environment. To help ensure all schools support a school climate where students can learn and focus, New York State passed the Dignity for All Students Act in 2012 which created procedures to ensure every school environment is free of discrimination and harassment. School Closing Announcements

If the district needs to close before the start of the school day because of an emergency or weather, announcements will be made using text/email alerts, the district website, district social media and on local television & radio stations.

If the district needs to close school early during the school day, an automated phone call will also be made to all designated student emergency contacts. Please ensure your Emergency Contact Information is up to date with your school's main office so you can receive these communications.

Safety Drills

To help ensure the safety of our students, faculty and staff, all Schodack schools practice safety drills throughout the school year with the assistance of police and emergency responders. As of the 2024-2025 School Year, the New York State Education Department now requires districts to notify school families within one week before a safety drill occurs. If you have a question about safety drills, please contact your student's principal.

Free Breakfast & Lunch for All Students

As of December 1, 2023, all students enrolled in Schodack Central School District are eligible to receive free breakfast and lunch every school day.
