



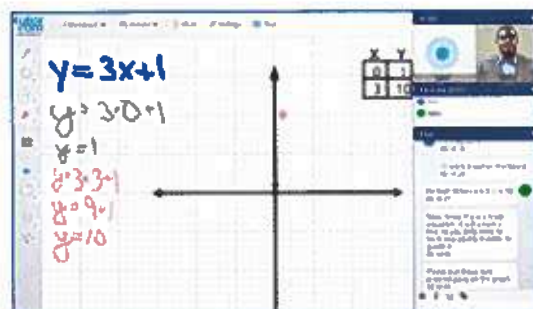

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The Online Classroom

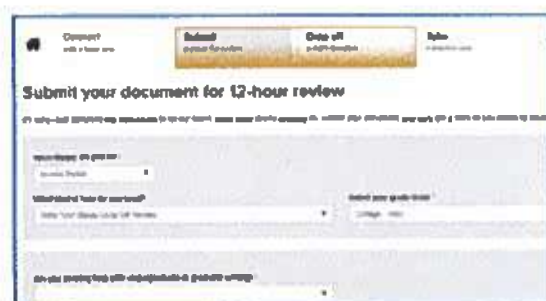
The online classroom provides several different tools to communicate with your tutor and tackle our question. You can chat with your tutor, use the audio feature to speak with them, draw on the interactive whiteboard, share files, share websites, and use the graphing calculator or the text editor. Access to most tools is available at the top of the classroom. Ask your tutor if you need help!



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Drop-Off Reviews

If you are short on time or would just like a more in-depth review of your writing assignment, math problem or résumé and cover letter, you can use the Drop-Off Review services. Just answer a few questions to explain your assignment or job search, upload your file and a tutor or career coach will send back a review within 12-24 hours.



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Practice Quizzes & Test Prep

Use the Practice Quizzes as a quick check of your knowledge on a specific topic before a class quiz or end-of-unit test. Use the SAT/ACT Test Prep to take full-length practice tests, receive a score report with areas of focus, watch related video lessons, take practice drills and access resources related to the college application process.
